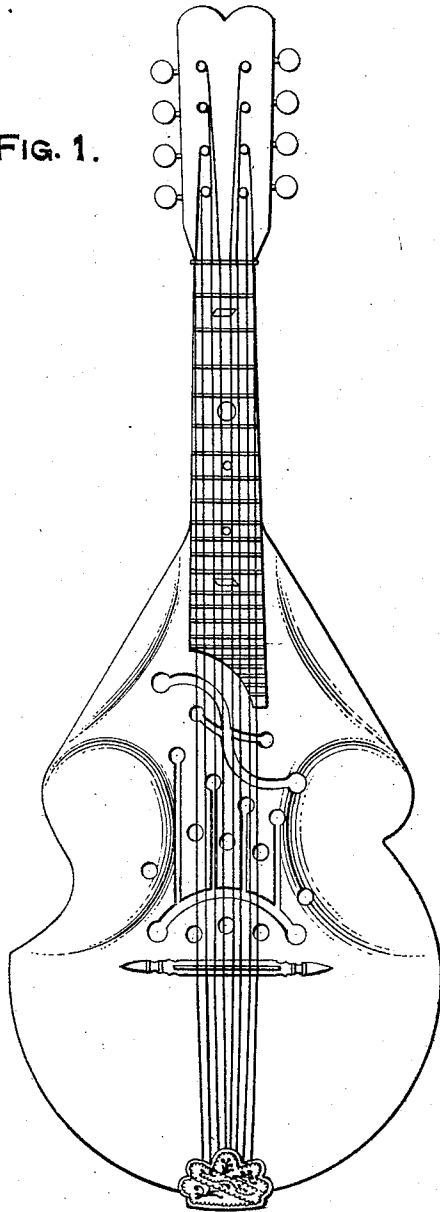
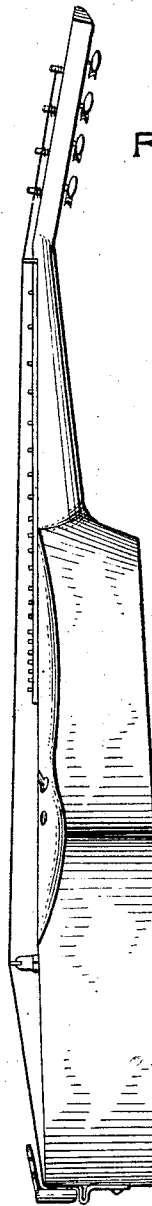

DESIGN FOR A MANDOLIN.

Application filed September 4, 1924. Serial No. 10,677. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LUIGI DI MILLO, a subject of the King of Italy, residing at Buffalo, in the county of Erie and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Mandolin, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the drawing forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is top plan view of a mandolin showing my new design, and
