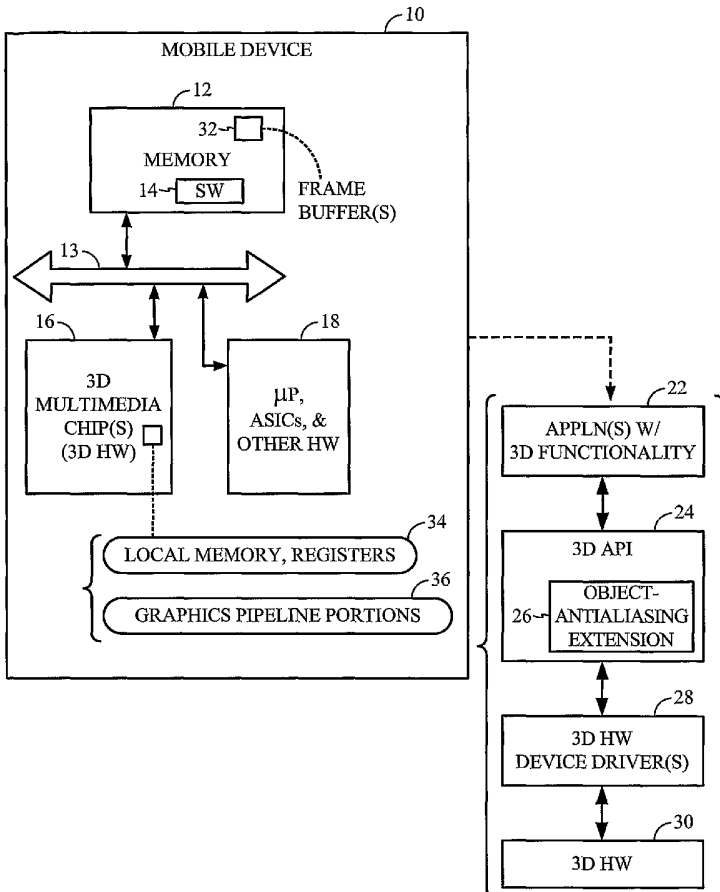

(54) Title: FLEXIBLE ANTIALIASING IN EMBEDDED DEVICES



(57) Abstract: A three-dimensional (3D) graphics pipeline renders a sequence of images of 3D scenes each composed of a plural set of objects. The pipeline comprises an antialiasing oversampling mechanism to perform for a given image, at an early stage of the pipeline, oversampling on a portion of the objects of the given image.
