

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Agatha S. Murphy, a citizen of the United States, residing at Las Vegas, in the county of Clark, and State of Nevada, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Detachable Ornamental Clip for Eyeglasses, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a detachable ornamental clip for eyeglasses, showing my new design,

Fig. 2 is a top edge elevational view,

Fig. 3 is a bottom edge elevational view, and Fig. 4 is an end elevational view.
