*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, WILLIAM H. HAWKEN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Honesdale, in the county of Wayne and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Glass Vessels, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
