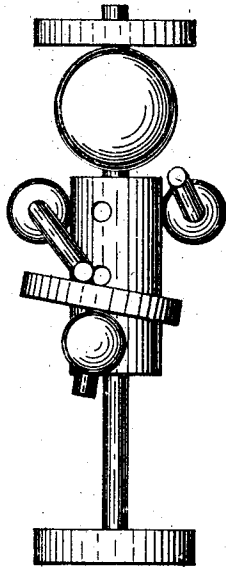

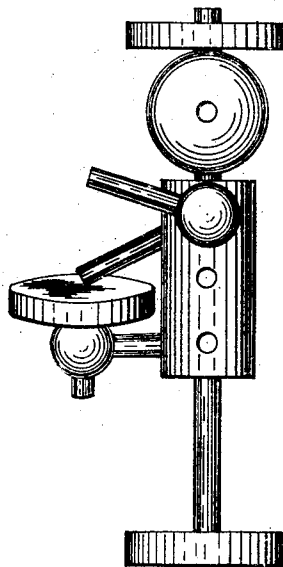

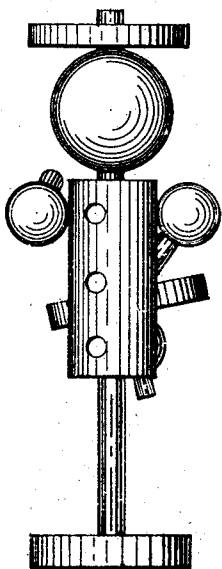
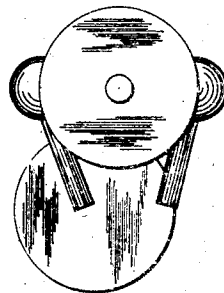

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HUGO KLAGSBRUNN, a subject of the Emperor of Austria, residing in the city and county of New Haven, State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Toy Figure, of which the following is a specification when taken in connection with the accompanying drawing.

In the drawing,

Figure 1 is a front elevation of a toy figure embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the same;

Fig. 3 is a rear elevation of the toy figure; and

Fig. 4 is a top plan view of the same.

What I claim is:

The ornamental design for a toy figure, substantially as shown.
