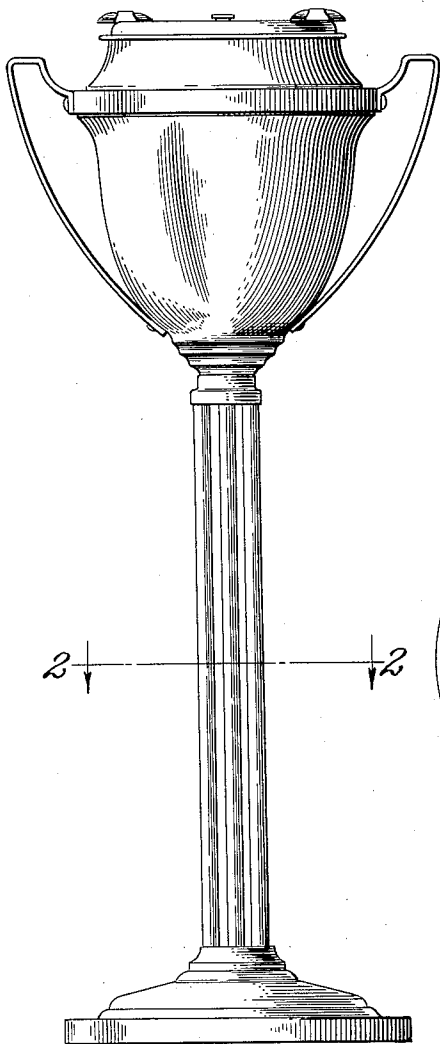
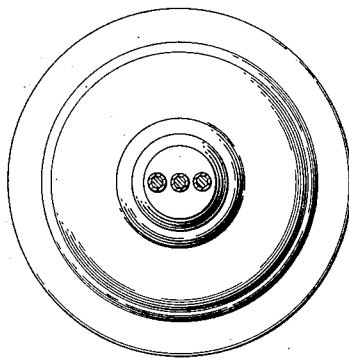

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Edward Schultz, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Smoking Stands, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevation, and Fig. 2 is a transverse section on line 2—2 of Fig. 1, showing the base in elevation, of a smoking stand exhibiting my new design.
