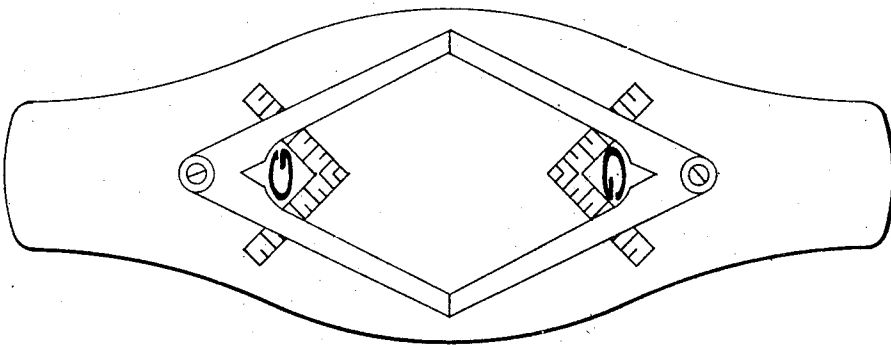

DESIGN FOR A FINGER-RING OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH C. BARKER, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Kansas City, in the county of Wyandotte and State of Kansas, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Finger-Ring or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

The figure is an edge view of a finger ring illustrating my new design.

The design comprises a diamond shaped

figure formed by two dividers, a pair of try-squares respectively crossing the legs of the dividers, and two letters G, occupying spaces between the arms of the try-squares and the legs of the dividers.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a finger ring or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
