

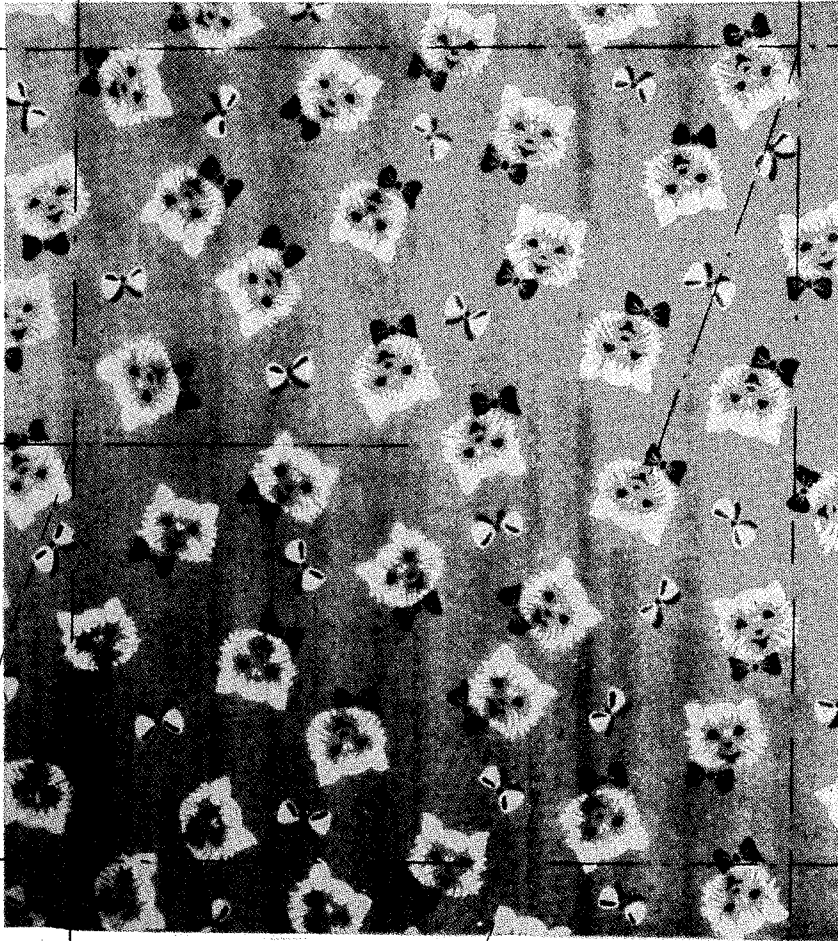

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Sidney Ross, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure on the drawing is a plan view of a textile fabric showing my new design. The dot

and dash lines on the drawing show the design unit, which unit is repeated in staggered succession as indicated by the angles A and A'.

The design is characterized by the contrasting appearance of the light and dark elements of the design and the specific arrangement of the light and dark bow elements all as shown.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a textile fabric, as shown and described.
