DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the modular furniture table design of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the modular furniture table shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a right side view of the modular furniture table shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a back view of the modular furniture table shown in FIG. 1;

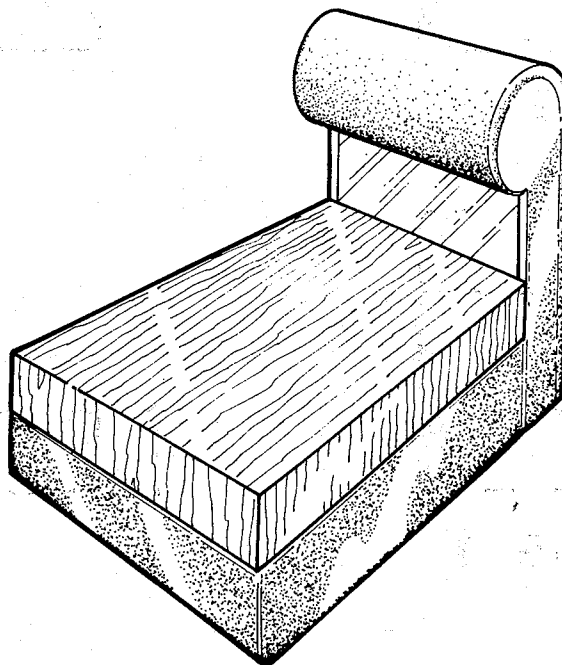
FIG. 6 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment of the furniture table design of the present invention;

FIG. 10 is a back view of the modular furniture table shown in FIG. 6.



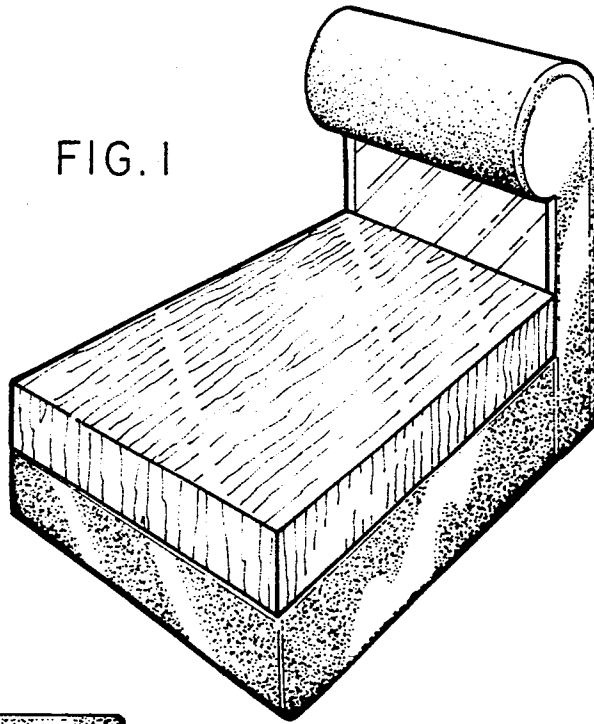

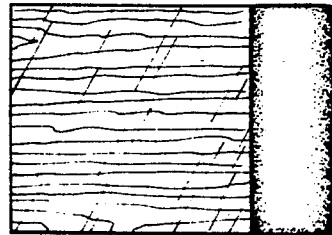

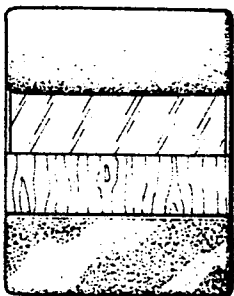

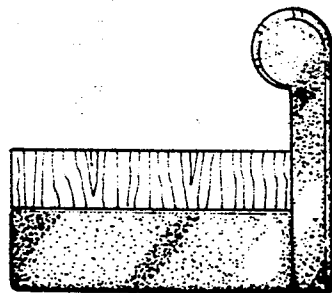

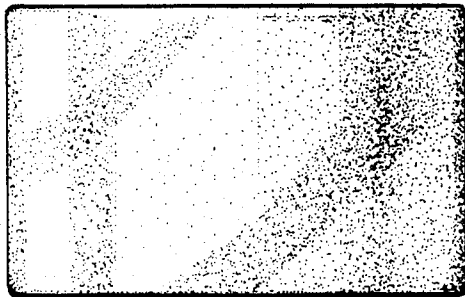
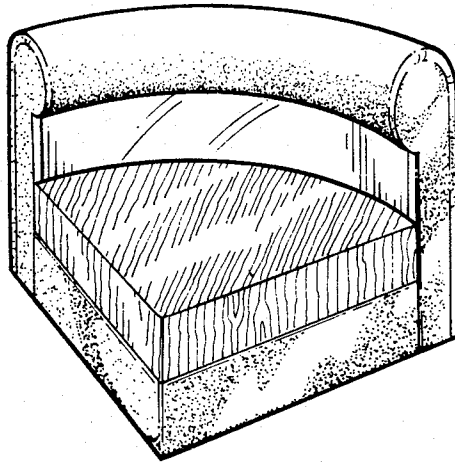

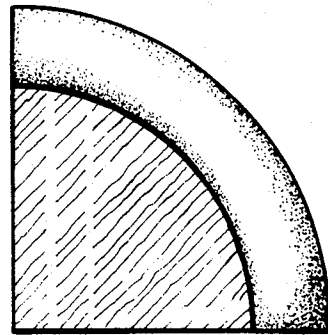

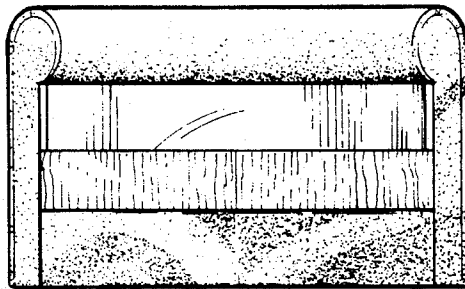

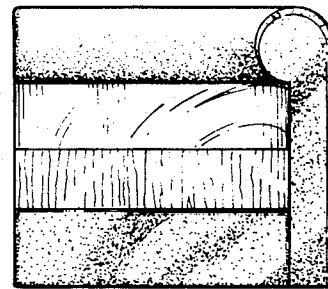
