DESIGN FOR CARPET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 28,126, dated January 4, 1898.

Application filed November 30, 1897. Serial No. 660,299. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WALTER CHARLES MAGEE, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, county of New York, State of New York, have invented or produced a new and original Design for a Pattern to be Wrought into Carpetings, in such coloring as may be designed; and I do hereby declare that the illustration accompanying this specification gives and conveys to any one skilled in the art of carpet weaving and manufacture a clear understanding of the same and is suffi-
