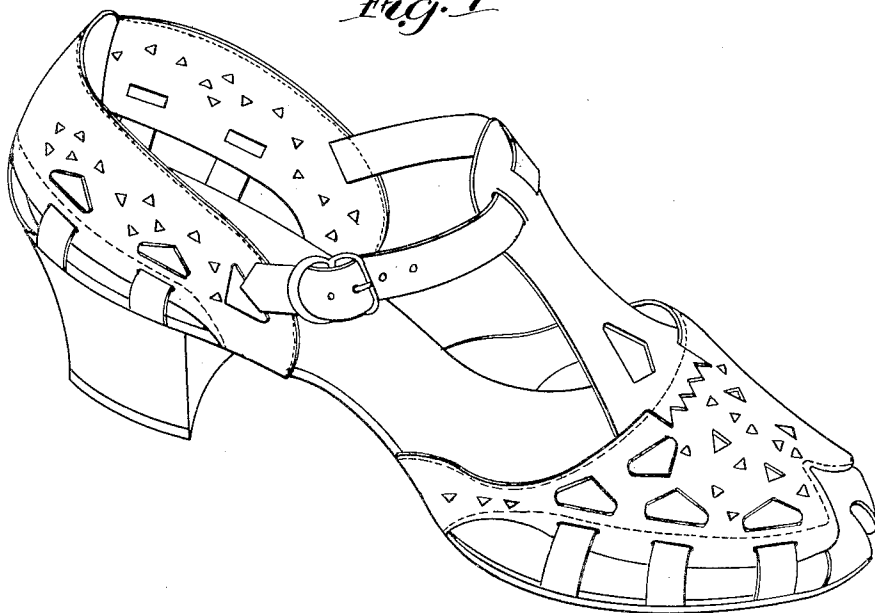
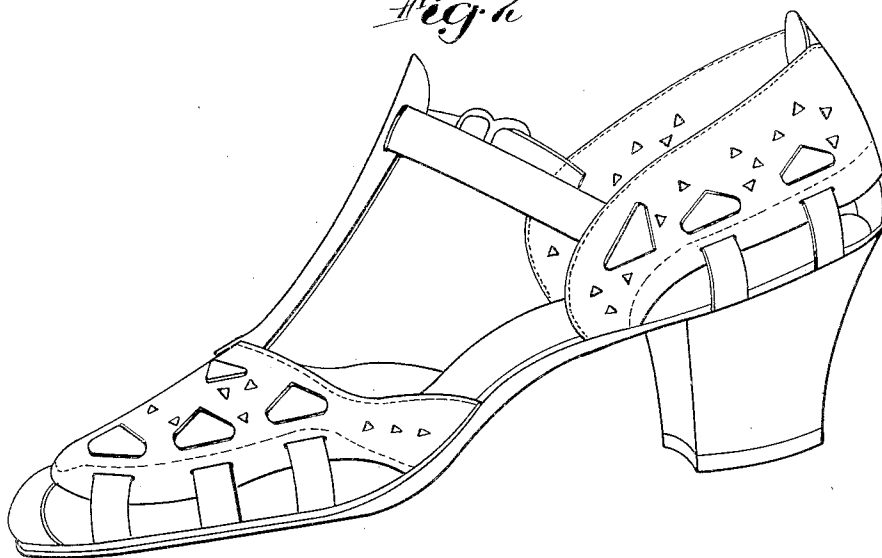

DESIGN FOR A SHOE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Morris Rosenston, a citizen of the United States, residing at Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof.

In said drawing,

Fig. 1 is a view, slightly in perspective, looking toward one side of a shoe or similar article, showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a similar view looking toward the opposite side of the shoe or similar article shown in Fig. 1.
