The electrical plug shown in broken lines in FIGS. 1 and 3-6 is for illustrative purposes only and is not part of the claimed design.

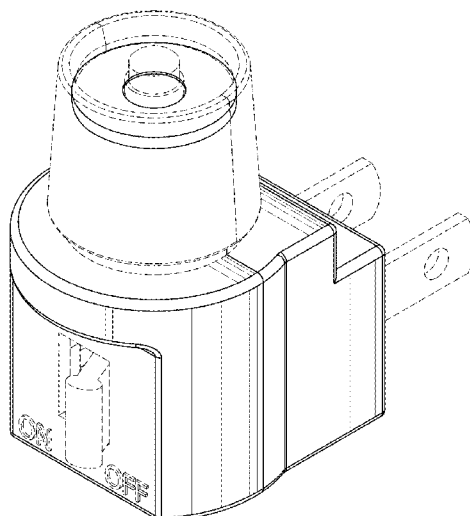
The screw head and accompanying indentation shown in broken lines in FIGS. 4 and 6 is for illustrative purposes only and is not part of the claimed design.

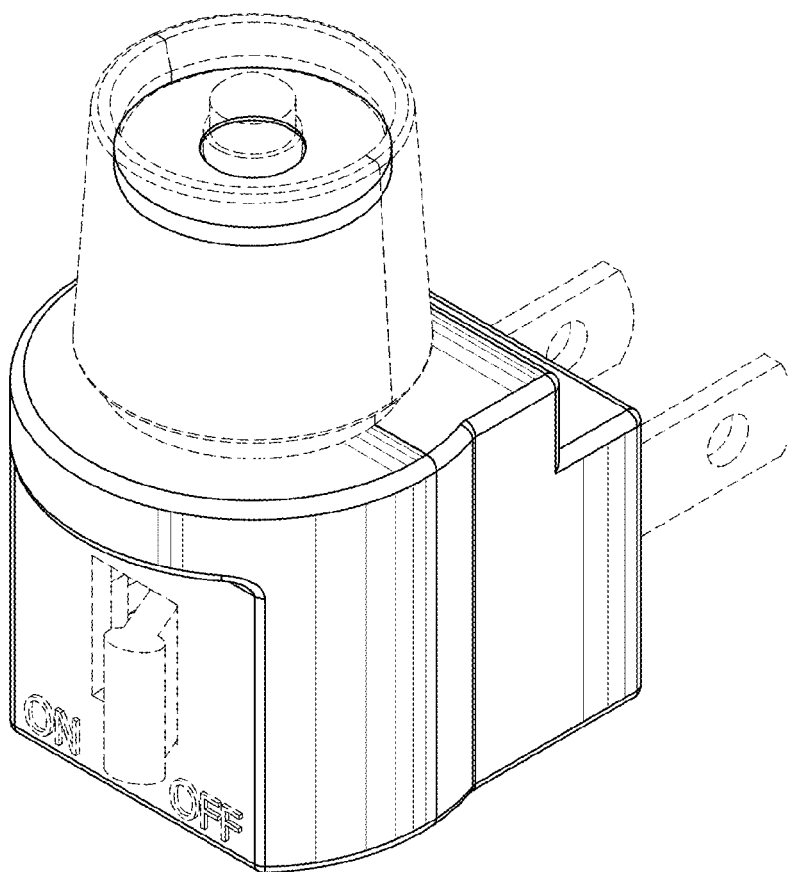

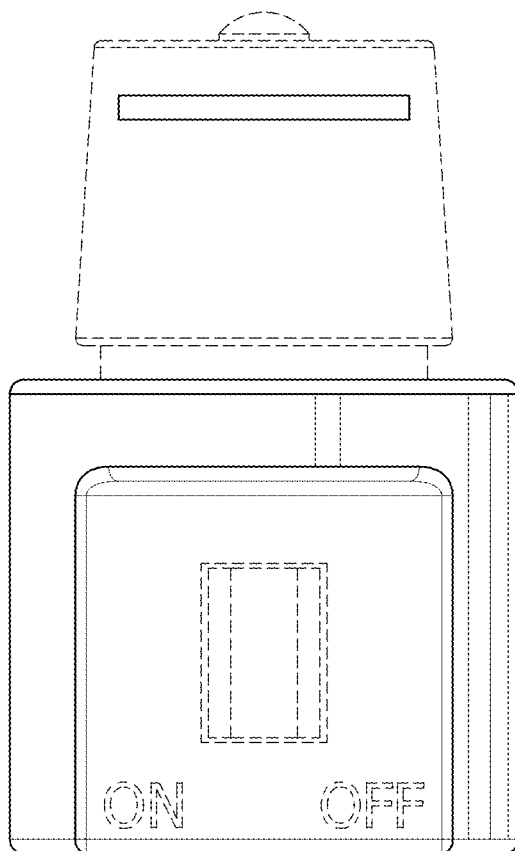

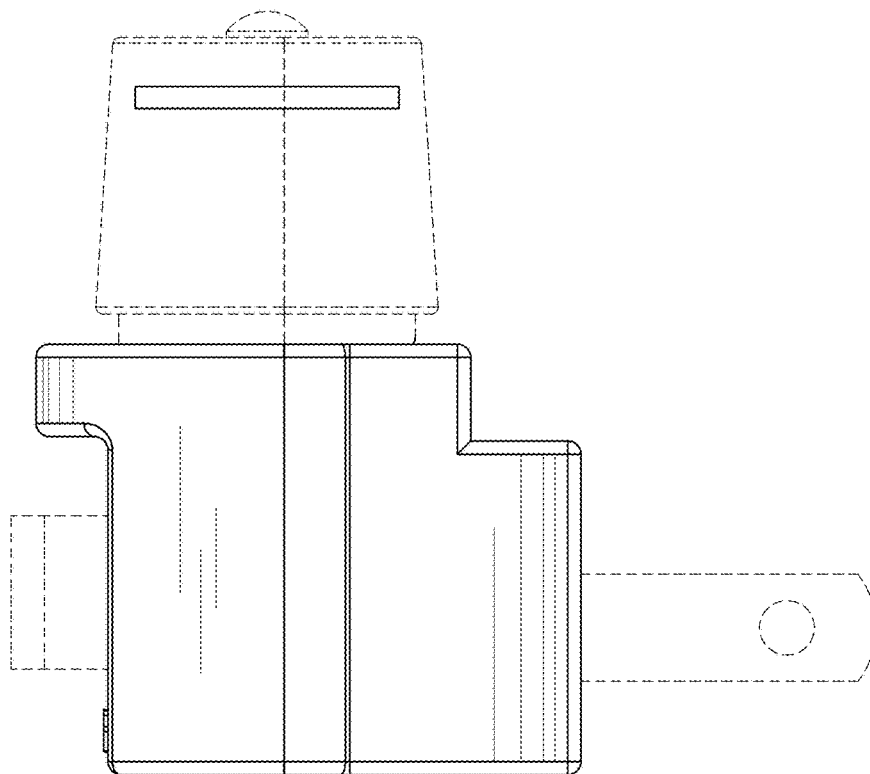

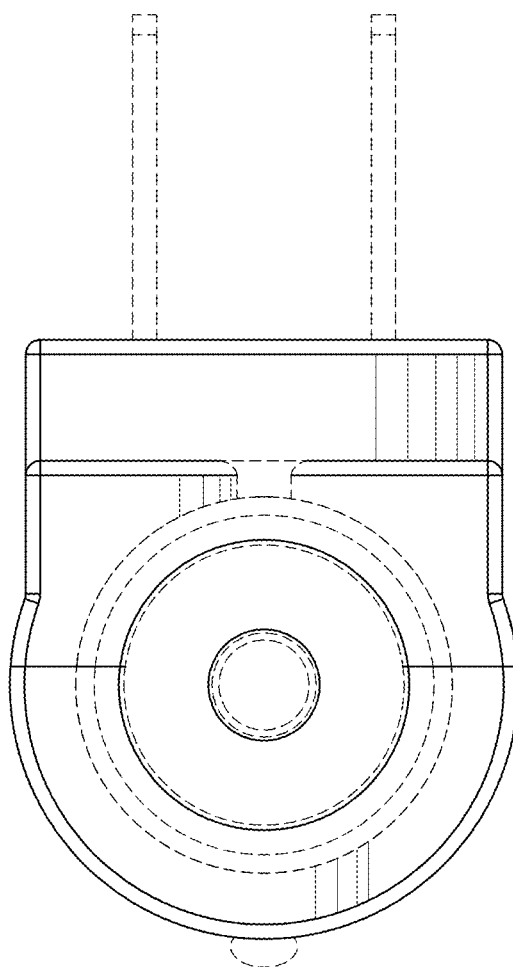

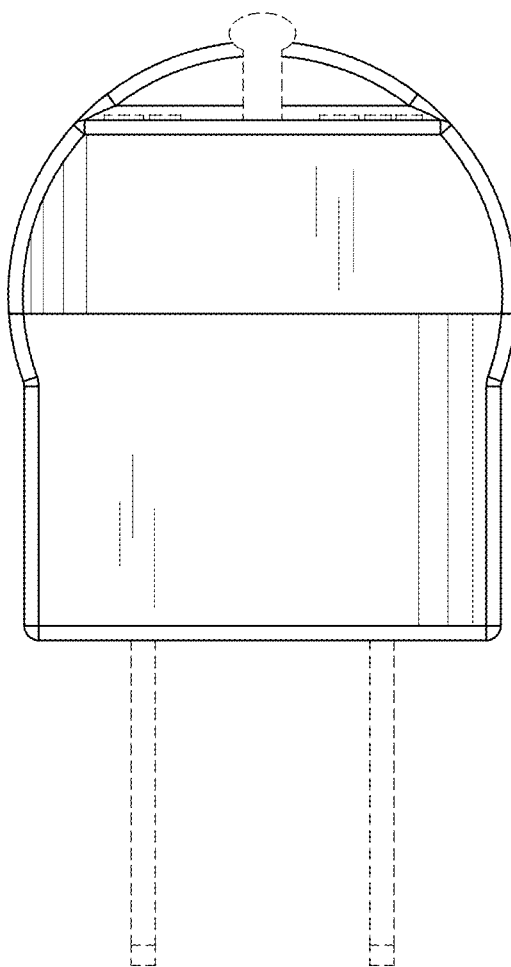
