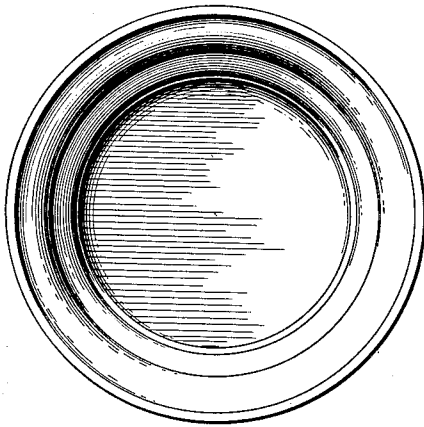
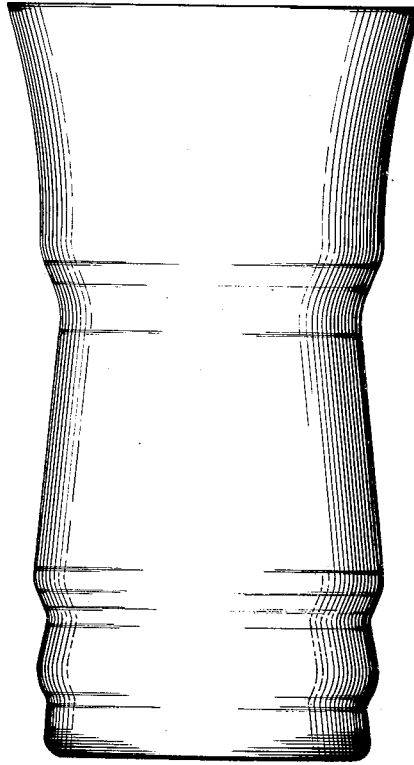

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles Sawyer, a citizen of the United States, residing at Toledo, in the county of Lucas and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original and ornamental Design for a Tumbler, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
