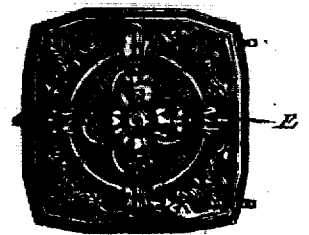
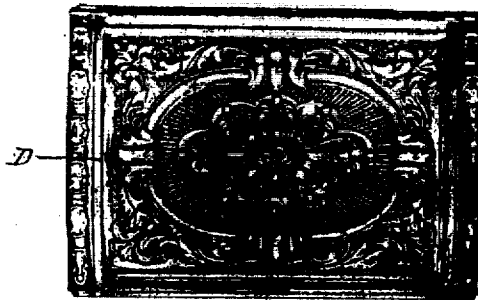
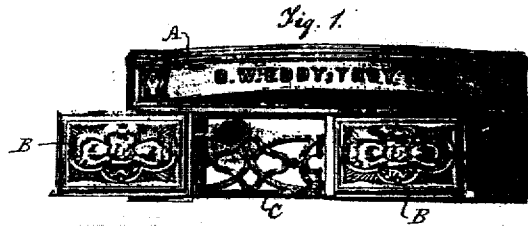

Letters Patent, No. 1027, dated July 13, 1868.

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, N. S. Vedder, of the City of Troy, in the County of Rensselaer, and State of New York, have invented or produced a new and original Design for certain plates of an Elevated Oven Cooking Stove, called the "Lion of the West," & I do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description of the same, reference being had by the letters to the annexed photographic drawings making a part of this specification, in which

Fig. 1, represents the front of the fire-box of the stove;

Fig. 2, the front plate of the oven; and

Fig. 3, a door at the end of the oven.




My ornamental design for the main front plate A, of the fire-box, on which the door B, slide and in which the fire-grating or open-work plate C is set, consists of a sunk panel at each lower corner, (only one panel shown,) wherein is arranged the rays a, proceeding from a raised oval center b, and the ornament c placed in each upper corner of the ends of the projecting portion d, of the plate. My design for each of the doors or plates B, consists of the large central flower of four expanded petals, d, & others, e, unopened, surrounded by rays, f, and set as shown upon the oblong rectangular panes of the doors. My design for the open-work plate C consists of the strips g and parts h interlaced or crossed and arranged together as shown in Fig. 1, wherein one half of the grating is shown, the other part being the counter-part of, or the same as that exhibited. My ornamental design for the front plate D, of the elevated oven consists of the central flower of eight expanded petals, (t,) and some others, (v,) covering its center, surrounded by rays, j, in front of which letter is placed the oval frame k, having clamps l holding the united scroll branches m. The whole being disposed on the oblong sunk rectangular panel of the plate as shown in Fig. 2. My design for the door or plate E, of the end of the oven consists of the flower n of four spread petals and others closed, the rays o, circular molding p and the connected scroll-branches q held by the clasp r, all arranged together upon the twelve-sided panel of the door as shown in Fig. 3.
