







To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Alfred Vischer, Jr., a citizen of the United States, residing at Park Ridge, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Autoclave, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a right side elevational view;

Fig. 2 is a front elevation;

Fig. 3 is a rear elevation; and

Fig. 4 is a plan view of an autoclave, showing my new design.

The left side elevation is substantially the same as Fig. 1, except that the hinge, its spring, and the arcuate tube, do not appear.

I claim:

The ornamental design for an autoclave, substantially as shown and described.
