

(54) Title: ULTRAVIOLET RADIATION PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR AND PACKAGING



(57) Abstract: A preferred embodiment of the present invention is an eye protector (10) and packaging for providing ultraviolet radiation protection to individuals. The protective eyewear (10) includes a flexible, substantially flat substrate member (12) having eye covering portions (18). A bridge portion (q5) connects the eye covering portions (18), and temple segments (14) extend from opposing ends of the eye covering portions. An ultraviolet absorbing material (20) is applied over the eye covering portions (18). A contact adhesive (16) is applied to the substrate (12), preferably along the temple segments (14). The contact adhesive (16) removably adheres the eyewear (10) to a substantially flat backing member (30) or to an individual's temples.
