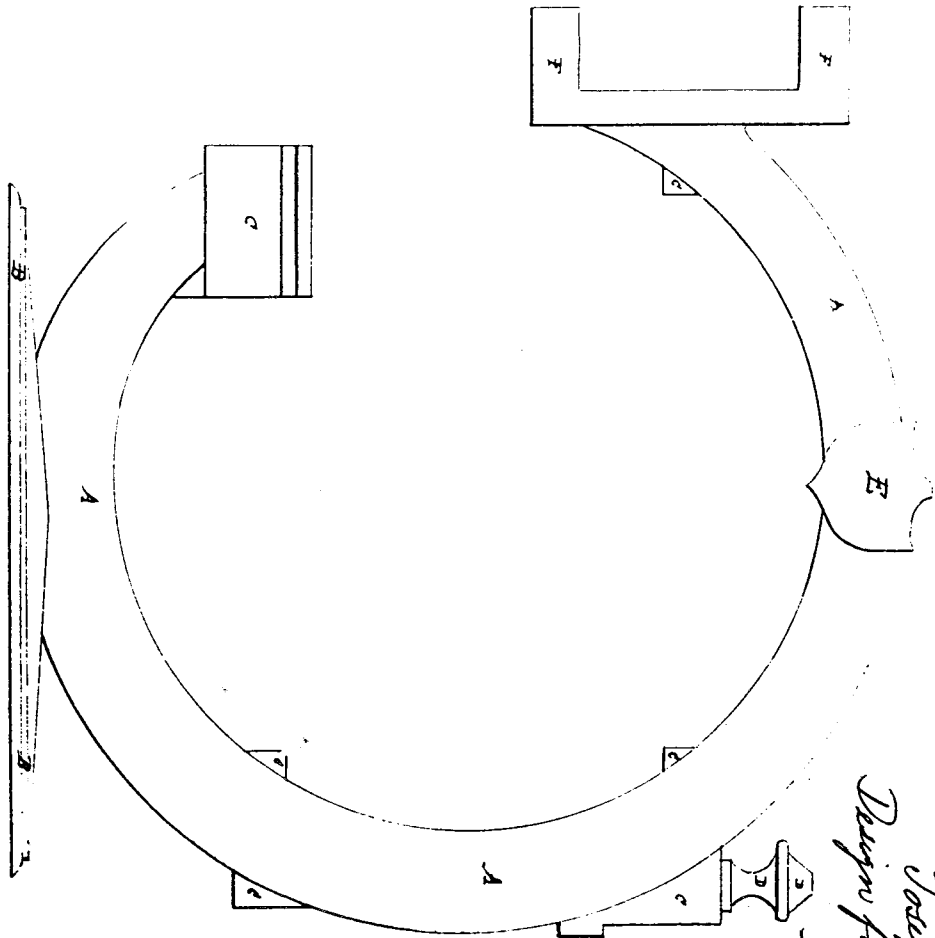

Design for the Frame of a Sewing Machine.

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same  
shall when it may concern

Be it known that I, Joseph W. Bartlett, of the City, County and State of New York, have invented or produced a new and original design for the Frame of Sewing Machines; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description of the same.

The drawings herewith annexed represent a declaration (full size) of the above mentioned design, the circular part A.A.A. is made round in its cross section. B.B. is the bed made four sided or square. C.C.C.C. are bearings for the shafts & are conical shaped urns placed to support the shaft rod. E. is a shield made for the purpose of containing the name or trade mark. F. These bearings for holding the sliding bars for the needle and pressure foot.

I claim the design for the frame of a sewing machine, substantially as shown and described.
