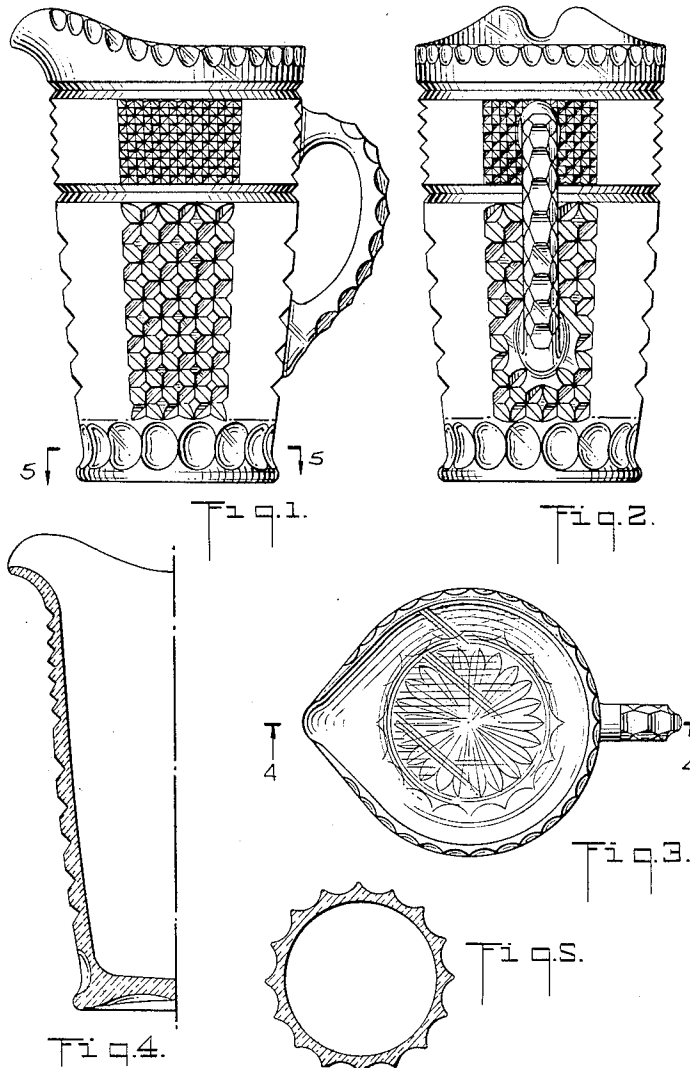

FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 3; and

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1.
