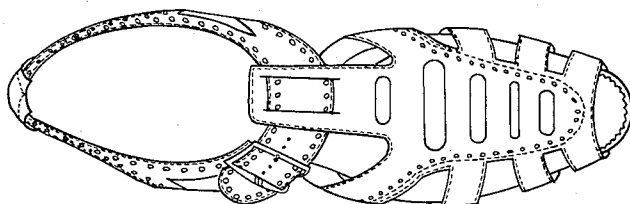

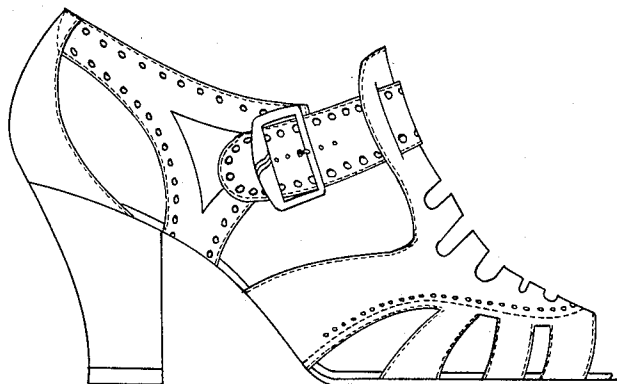

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Normand P. Liberty, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in Farmington, county of Strafford, and State of New Hampshire, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a shoe showing my new design.
