[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a decalcomania for china dinnerware or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of a first embodiment of a decalcomania for china dinnerware or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a plan view of a second embodiment of a decalcomania for china dinnerware or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 3 is a plan view of a third embodiment of a decalcomania for china dinnerware or similar article showing my new design; and

FIG. 4 is a plan view of a fourth embodiment of a decalcomania for china dinnerware or similar article showing my new design.

The decalcomania for china dinnerware or similar article is of no substantial thickness.
