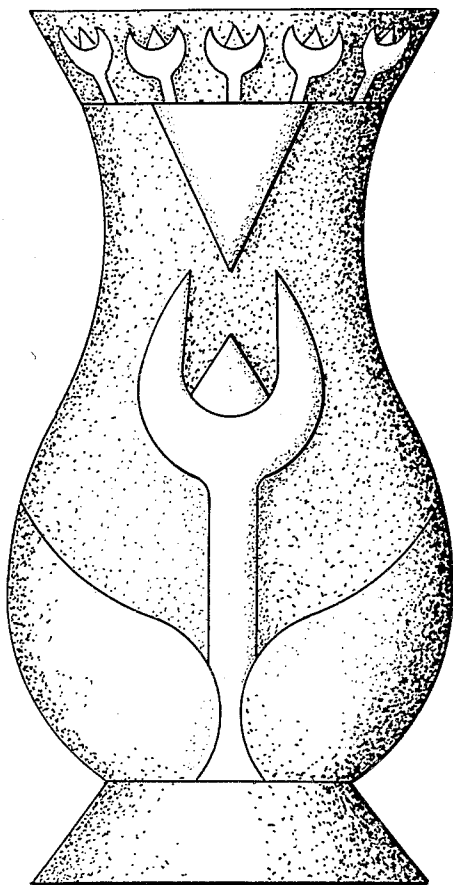

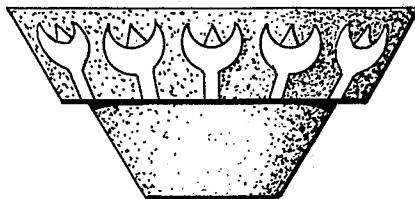

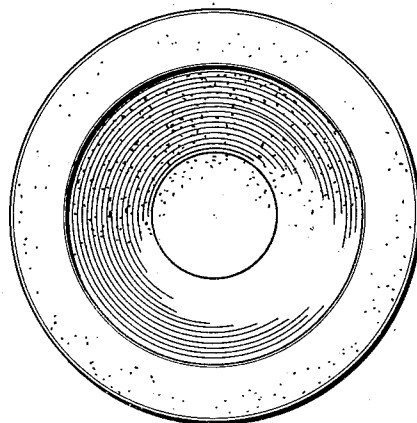

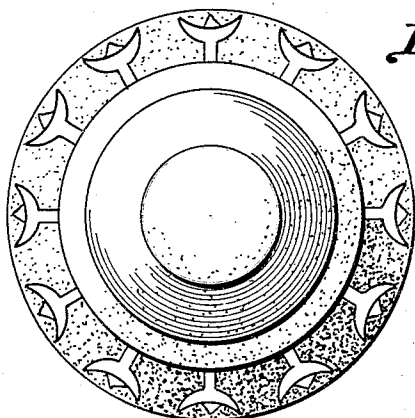

## DESIGN FOR A COMBINED FLOWER VASE AND BOUQUET HOLDER OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Edwin Reynolds, a citizen of the United States, residing at Vineland, in the county of Cumberland and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Flower Vase and Bouquet Holder or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a combined flower vase and bouquet holder showing my new design; the opposite side having the same identical ornamentation;

Fig. 2 is a detail side elevational view showing

the bouquet holder removed from the vase portion shown in Fig. 1.

Fig. 3 is a top plan view of the article as shown in Fig. 1; and

Fig. 4 is a bottom plan view of the bouquet holder shown in Fig. 2.

The dominant feature of my design consists in the surface ornamentation on the article.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a combined flower vase and bouquet holder or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
