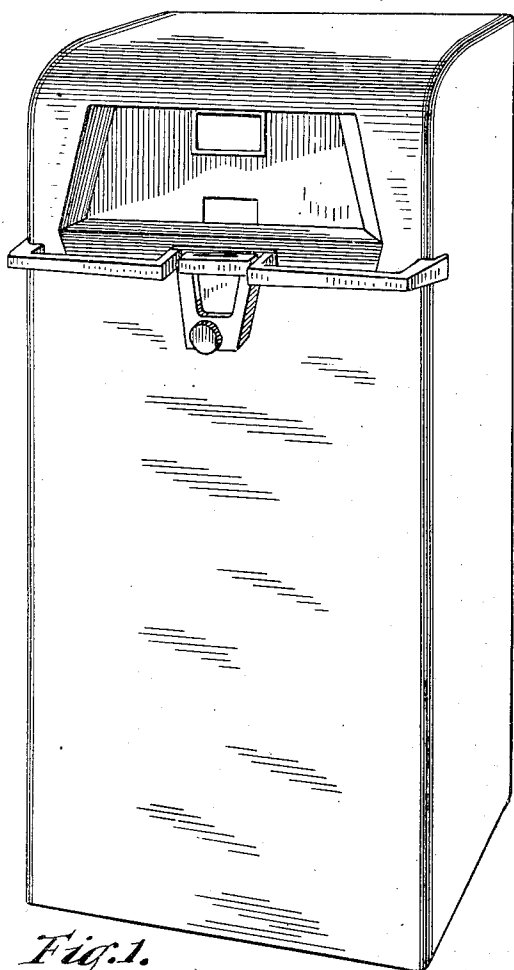

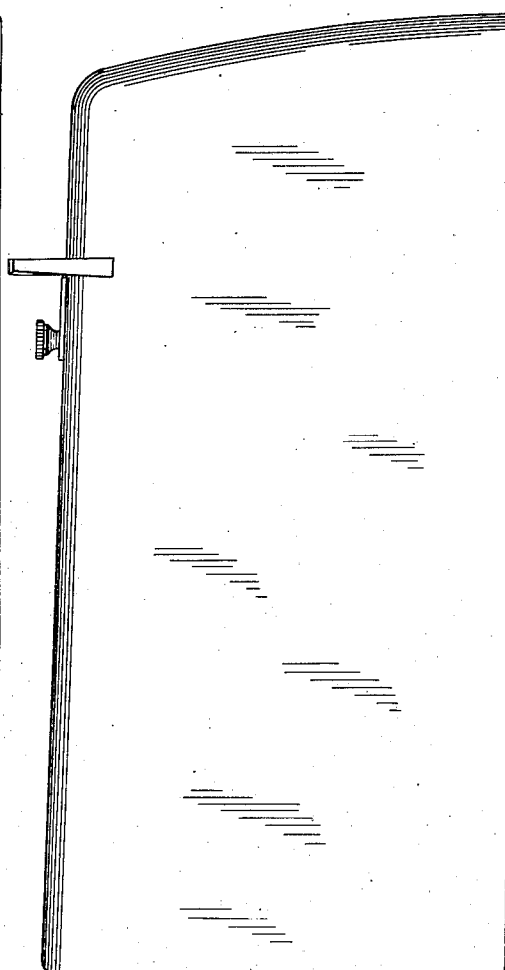

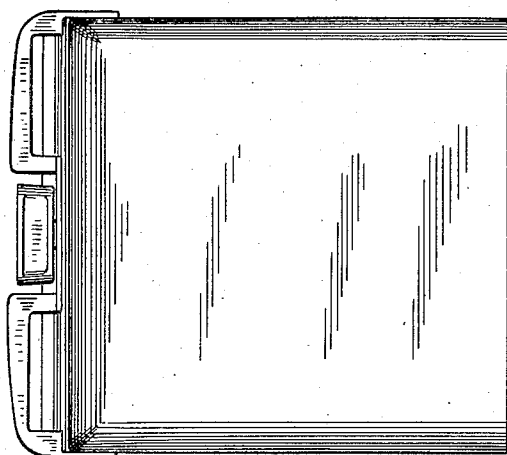

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Franz Wagner, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lubricant Cabinet or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a lubricant cabinet or the like, showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevational view of the lubricant cabinet shown in Figure 1; and

Figure 3 is a top plan view of the lubricant cabinet shown in Figure 1.
