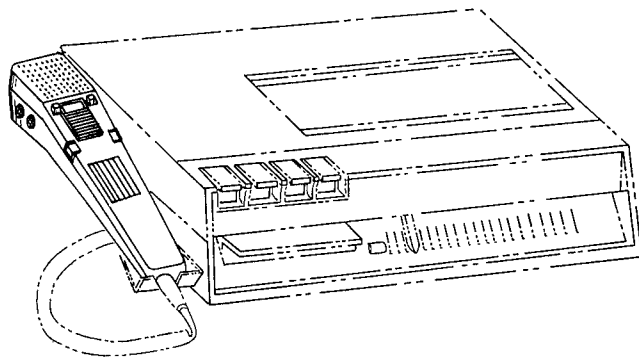

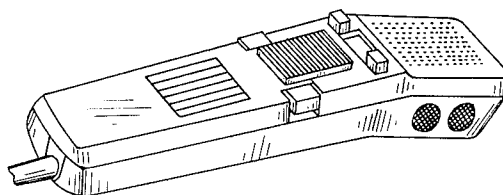

FIG. 1 shows an upper left-side perspective view of the microphone for use with a dictating machine which is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only, and

The bottom and end views of the microphone are not separately shown but are substantially smooth and unornamented and have length and width dimensions corresponding to the surfaces shown.
