

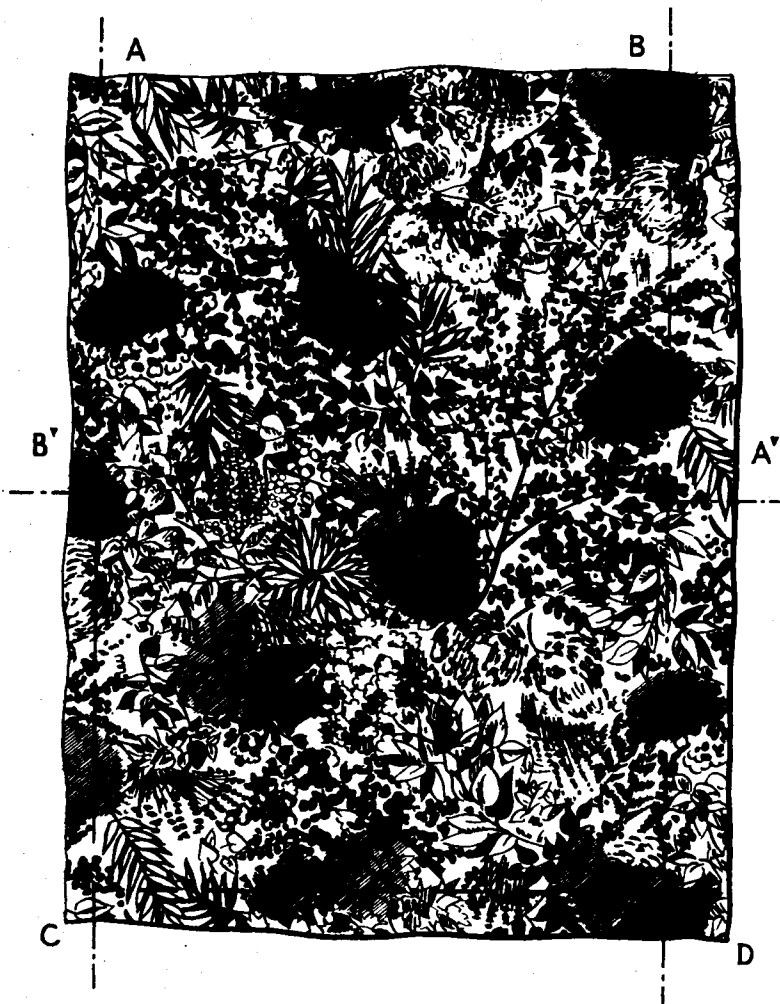

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed January 4, 1933. Serial No. 46,703. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM WILLHEIM, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 115 Central Park West, in the city of New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a textile fabric showing my new design. The unit of the

design is substantially contained between the two horizontal dot and dash lines AB and CD and the two vertical dot and dash lines AC and BD which unit is repeated in the relation wherein angle B corresponds to B¹ and A to A¹. The drawing is lined to indicate shading.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a textile fabric or similar article as shown and described.
