DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a cutlery center showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view and a mirror of the other side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a perspective view showing the cutlery center in assembled display condition, the broken lines showing knives carried by the center is for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

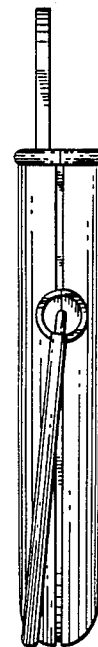
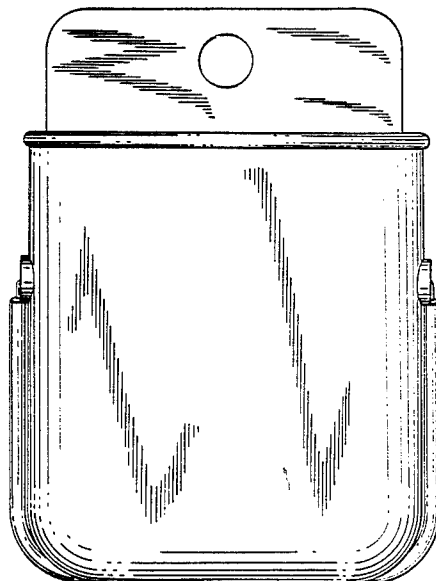

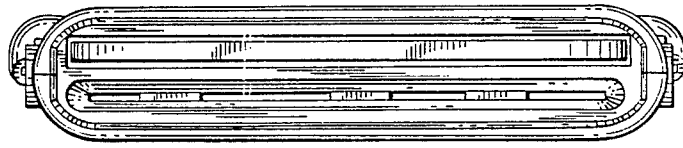

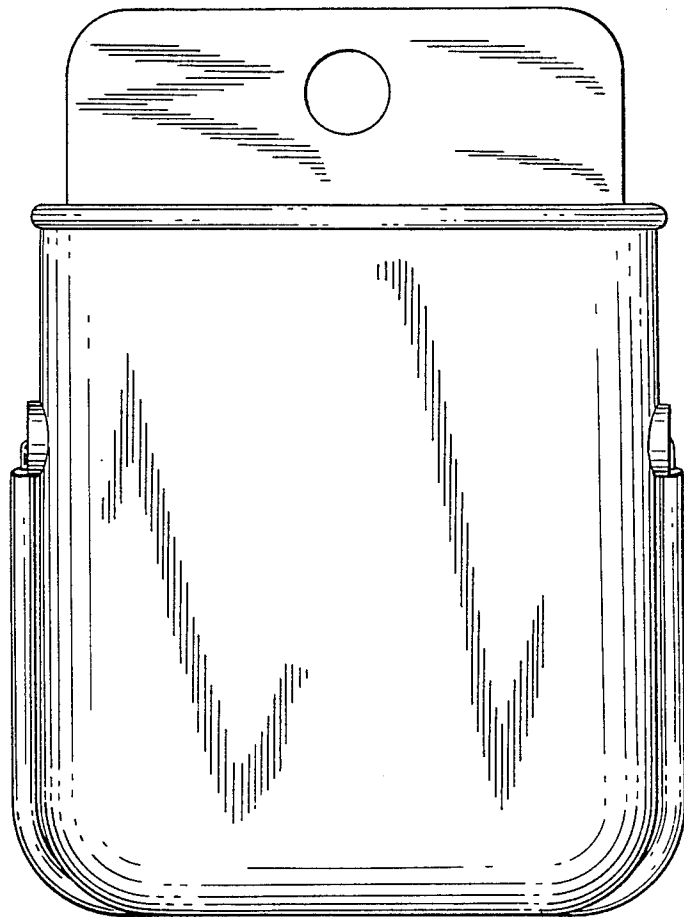

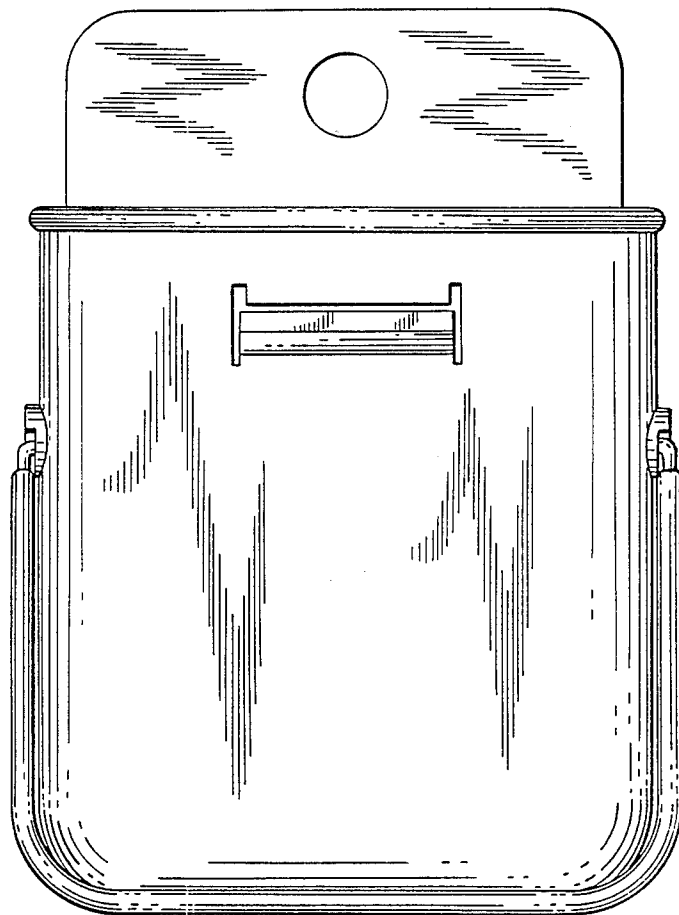
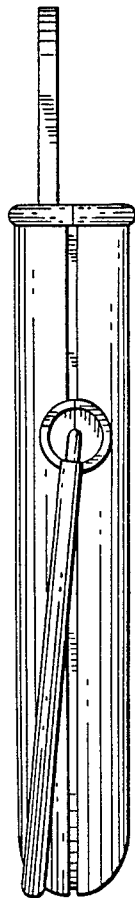

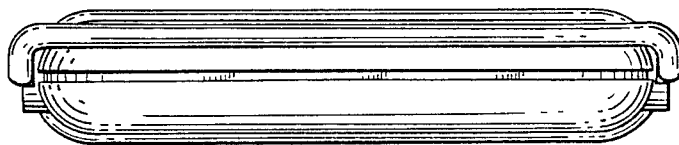
