The ornamental design for a light diffuser for electronic flash, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a light diffuser for an electronic flash showing my new design in a ready to mount condition;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

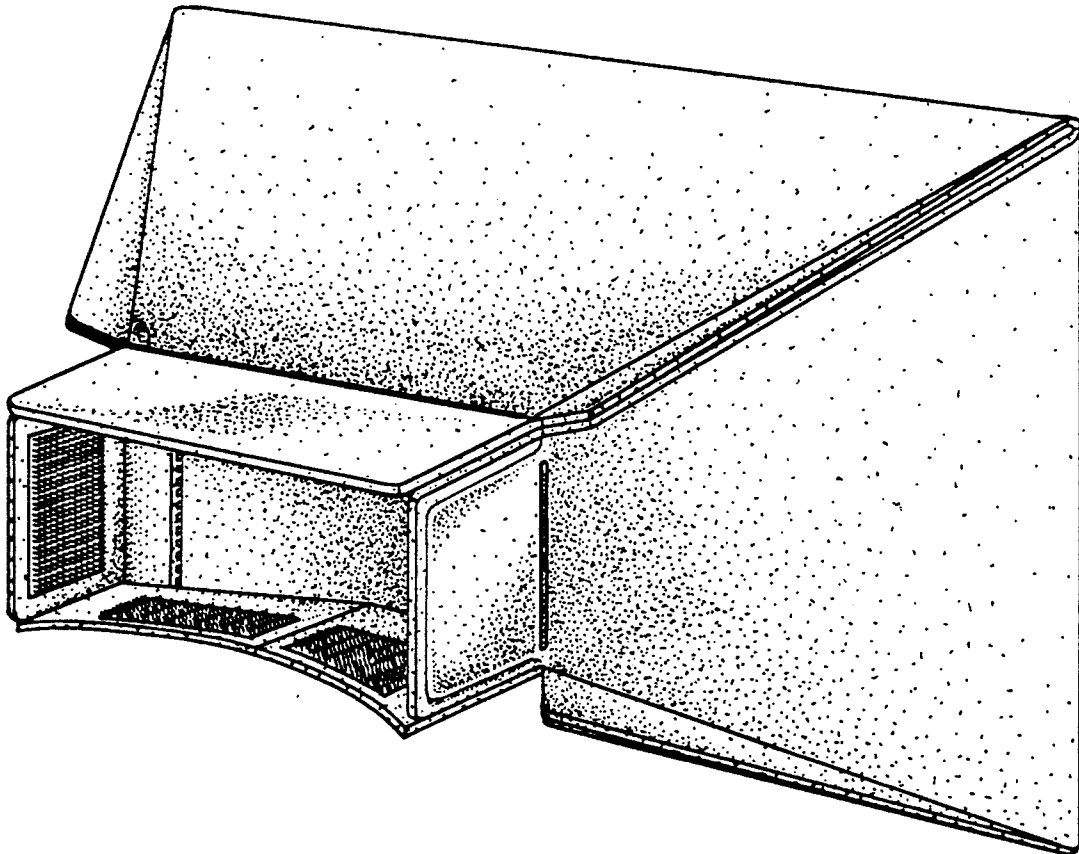
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

The broken line showing of the electronic flash unit is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



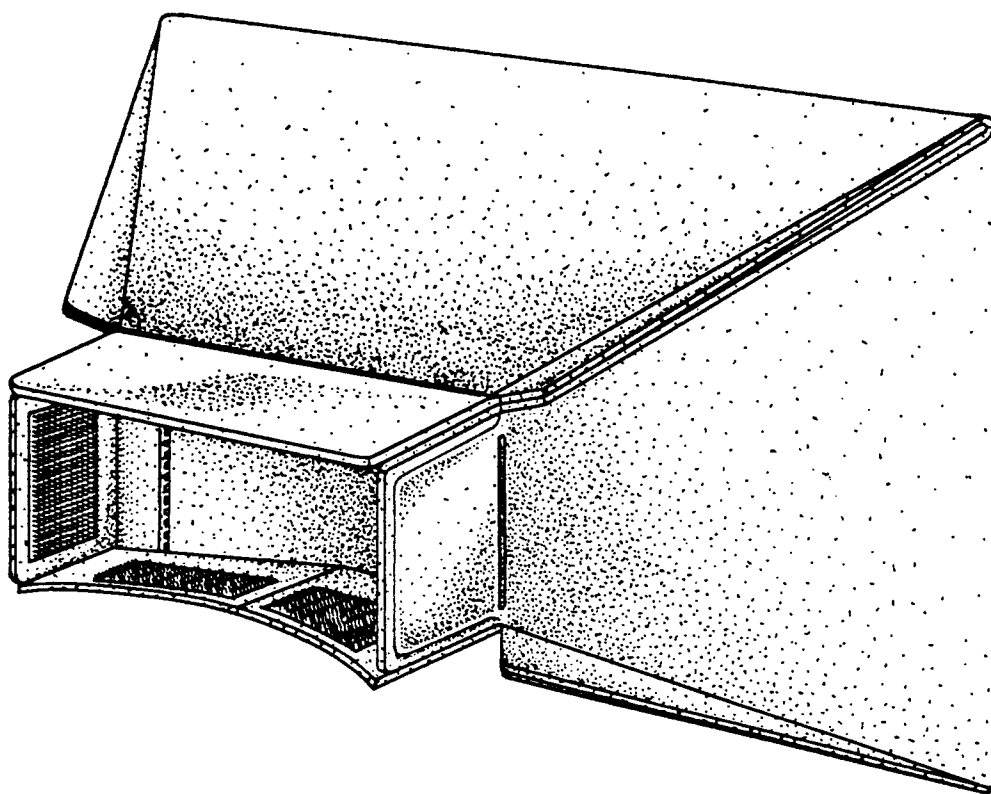

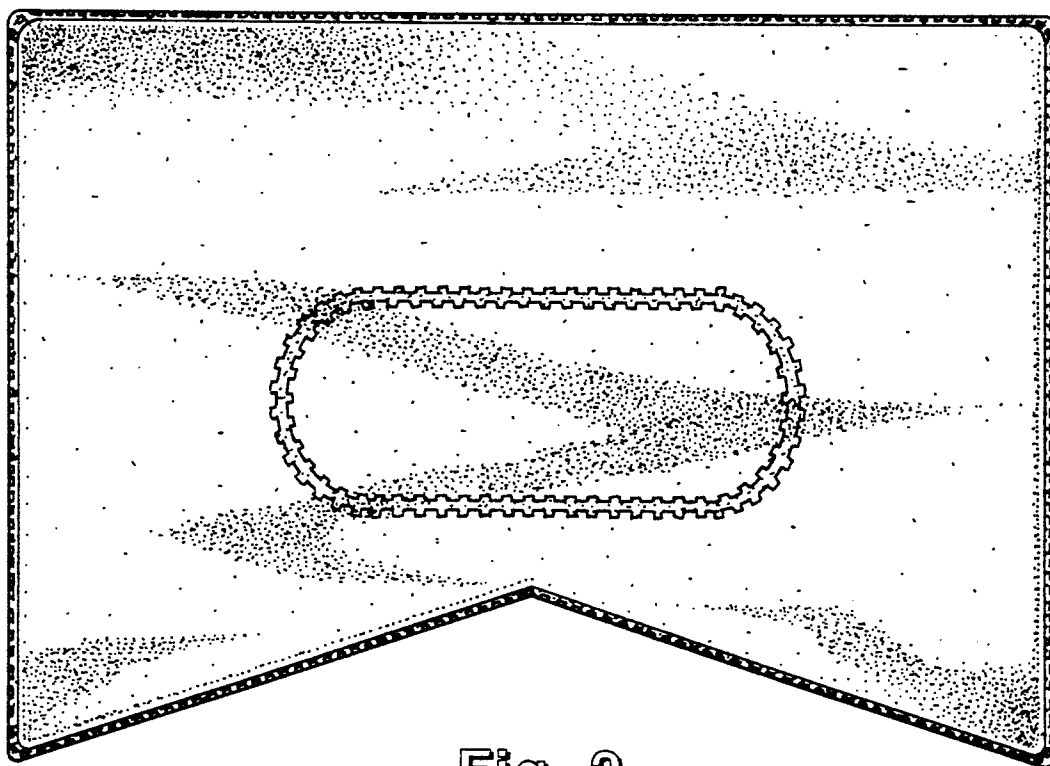

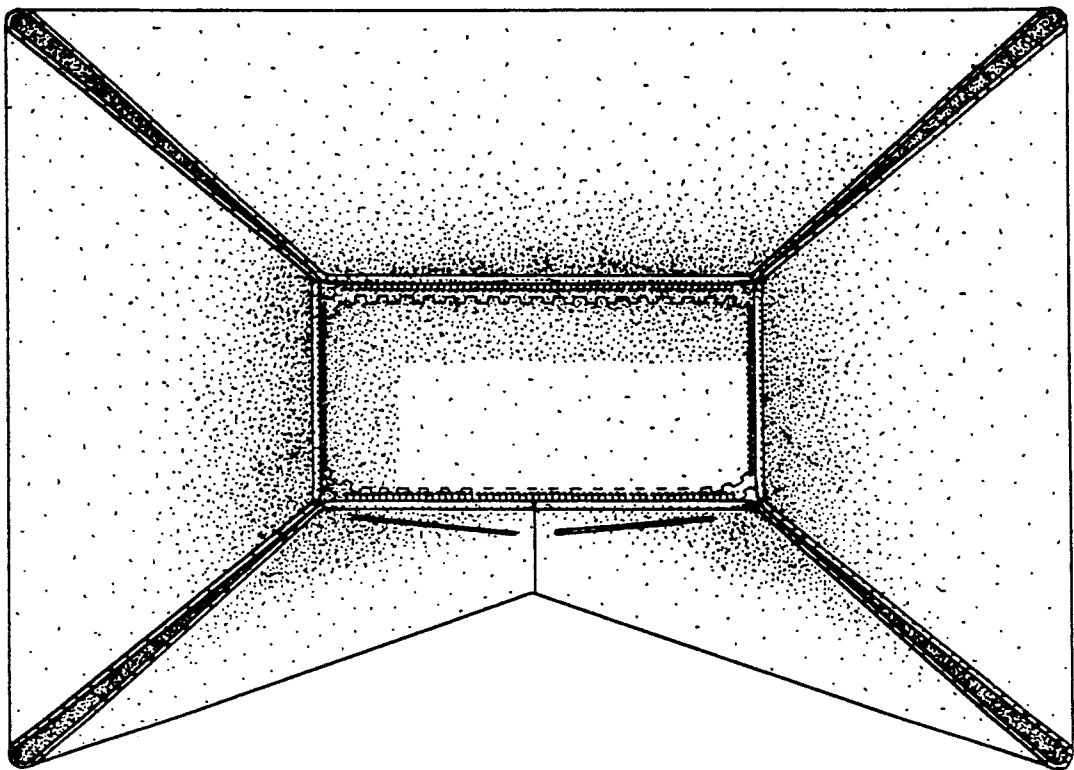

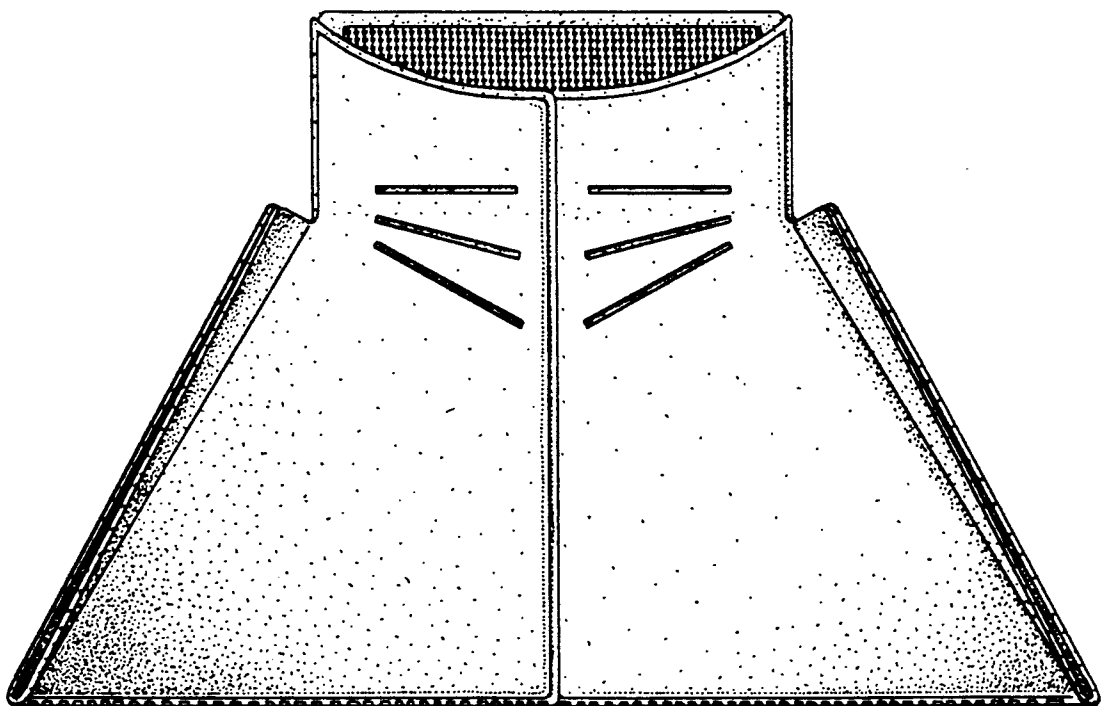

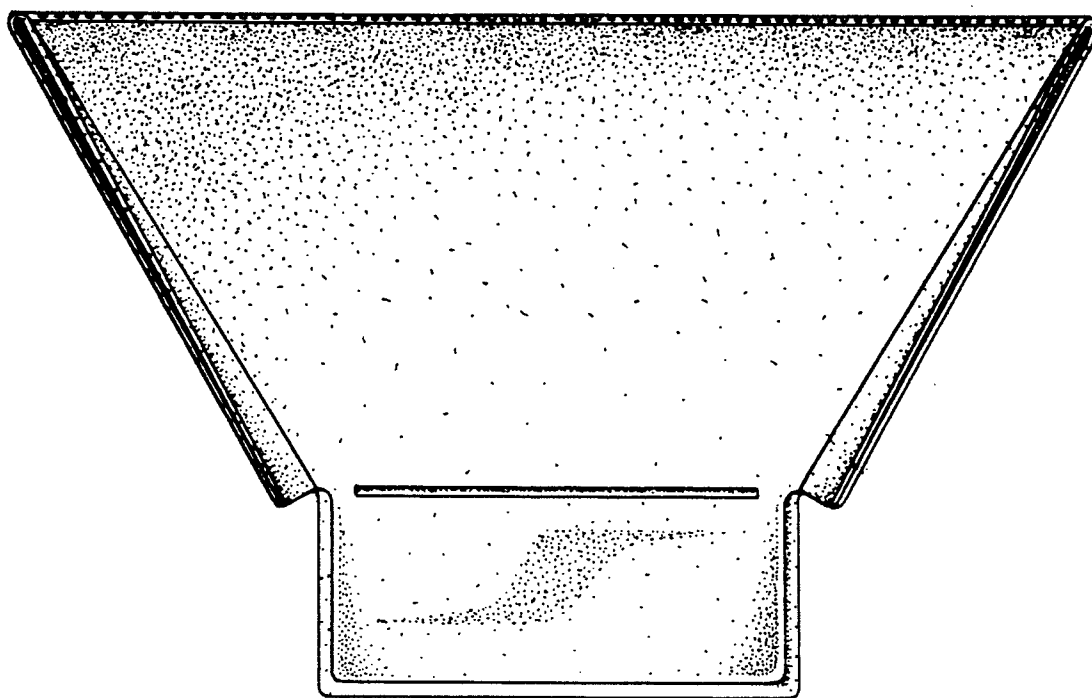

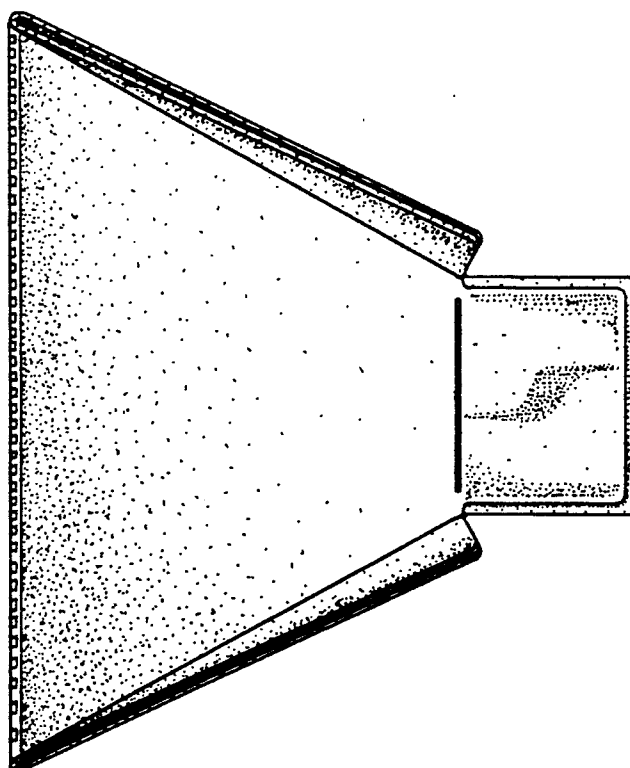

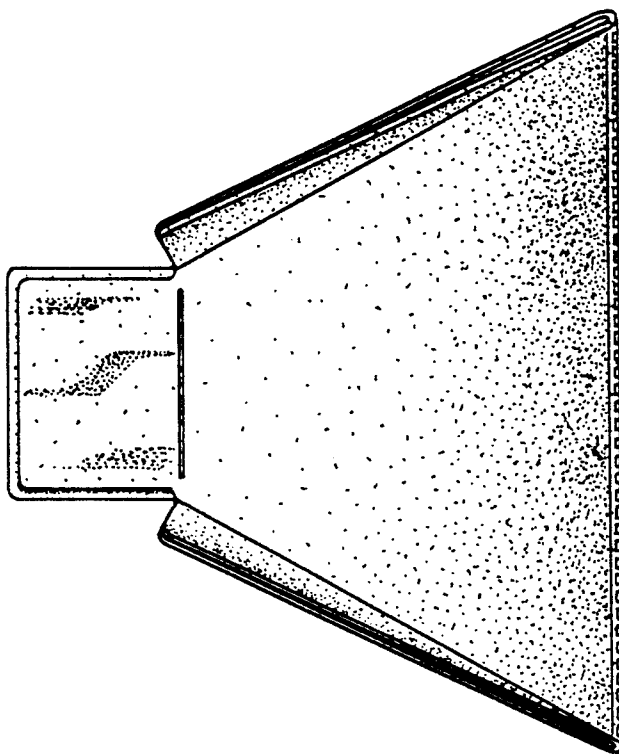

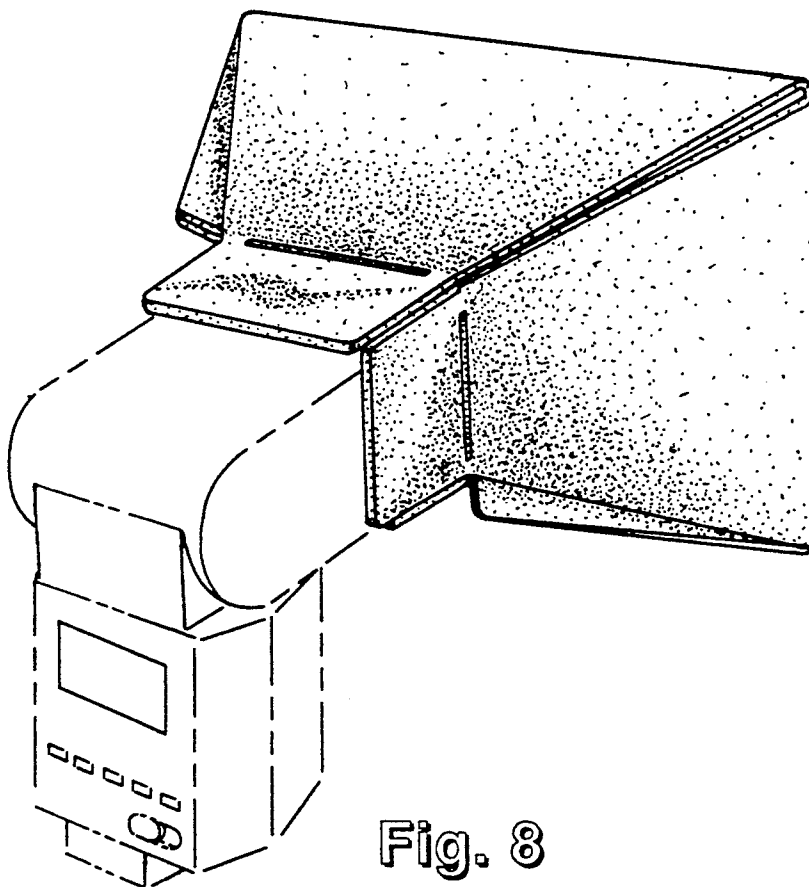

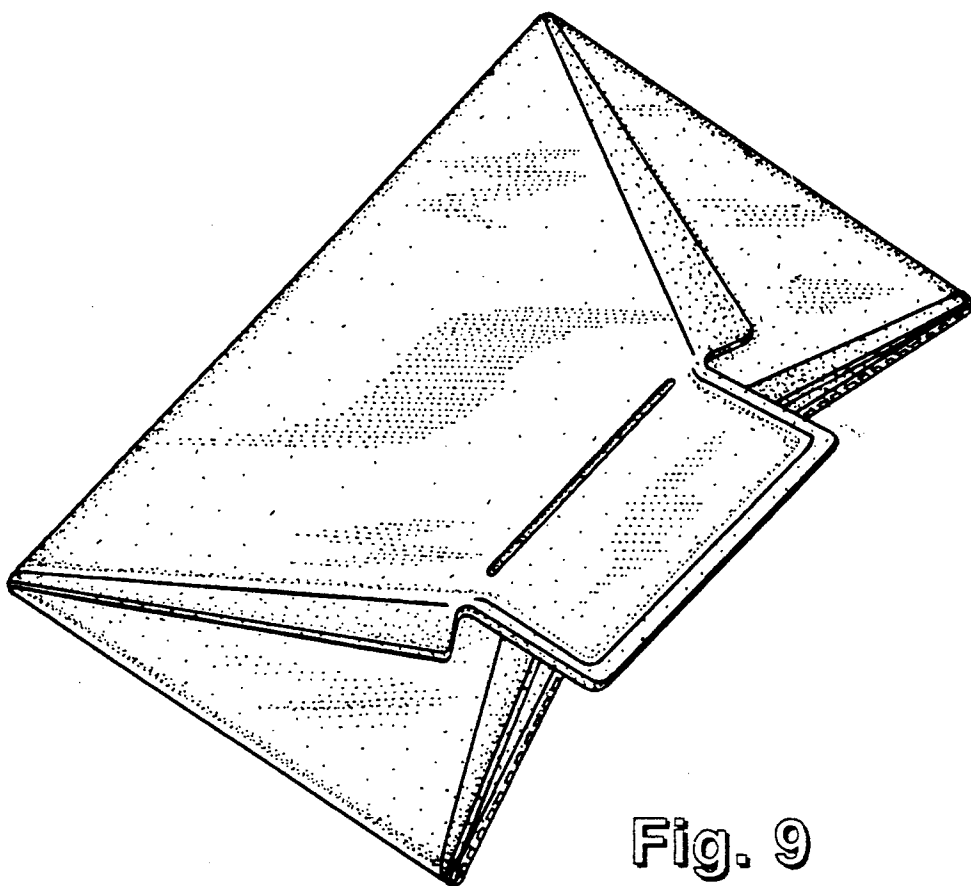
