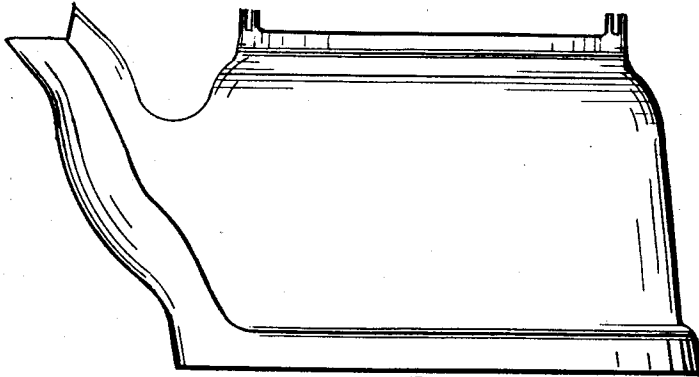

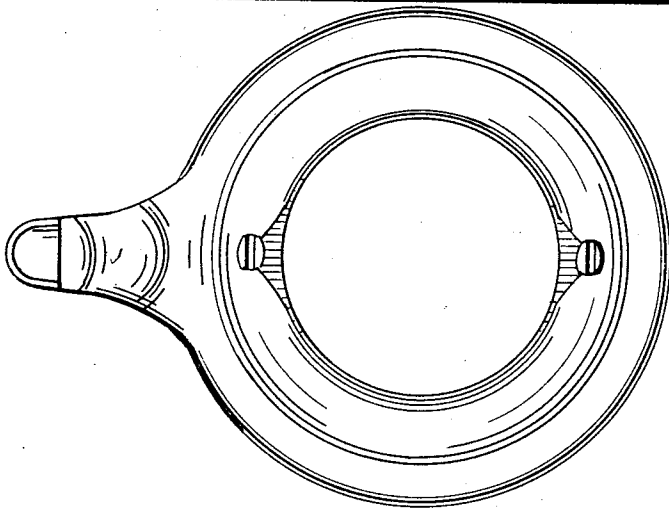

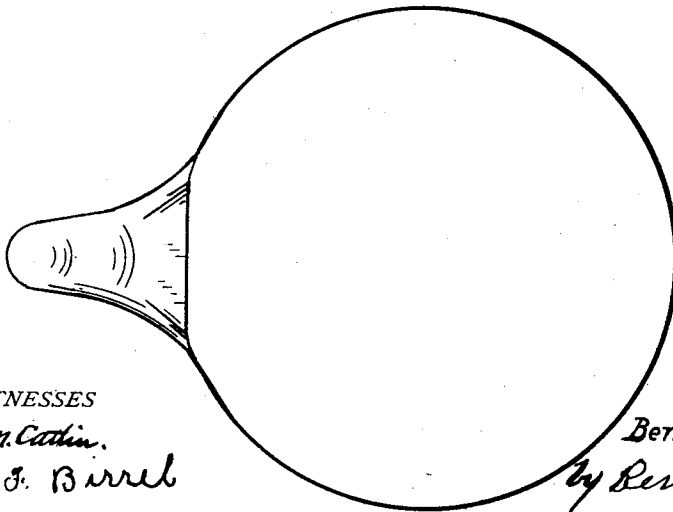

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, BERNARD P. WAGNER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Sidney, in the county of Shelby and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Tea-Kettles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
