The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern: Be it known that I, Waterman S. Ormsby, of the City of New York, in the State of New York, have invented, or produced, a new design, for an impression, or ornament, which is to be impressed on certain manufactures of Metal to wit, upon Metallic Combs; which ornamental design consists of a female figure having in her hands and over her head, festoons of flowers in which is inscribed the Motto "Forget me not"; and there being, both at the upper, and also at the lower, part of said ornamental design, a head, or mask, accompanied by ornamental scrolls, or devices, as shown in the accompanying impression therefrom, which I have deposited in the Patent Office, after being duly subscribed by me, and witnessed.

And I do hereby claim as of my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, the exclusive right to use and impress the said design, as herein described, and as specifically represented in the accompanying representation and impression thereof; the same to be employed for the purpose, and in the manner, set forth.
