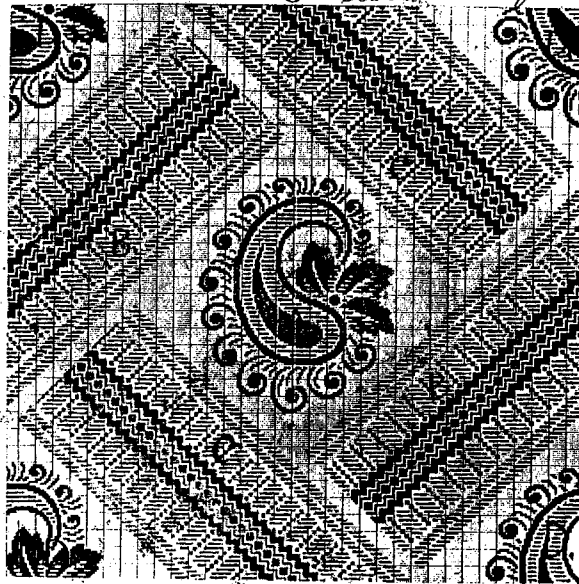

Design for a Carpet Pattern.

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The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

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To all whom it may concern:—

Be it known that I, Clemis J. Key, of Lowell, in the County of Middlesex and State of Massachusetts, have originated and designed a new Pattern for Carpets or other fabrics, of which the following is a full, clear and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, making part of this specification.

A, is a Palm Leaf.

B. B. are two bands running parallel with each other, and at right angles with C. C. overlapping each other and forming a big diamond.

D. D. D. D. are four quarters of a Palm Leaf similar to A.

The colors employed for the different portions of the design, may be varied to suit the taste and wish of the manufacturer.

Claim.

What I claim as my invention and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is the Design or Pattern for Carpets or other fabrics, herein set forth.
