

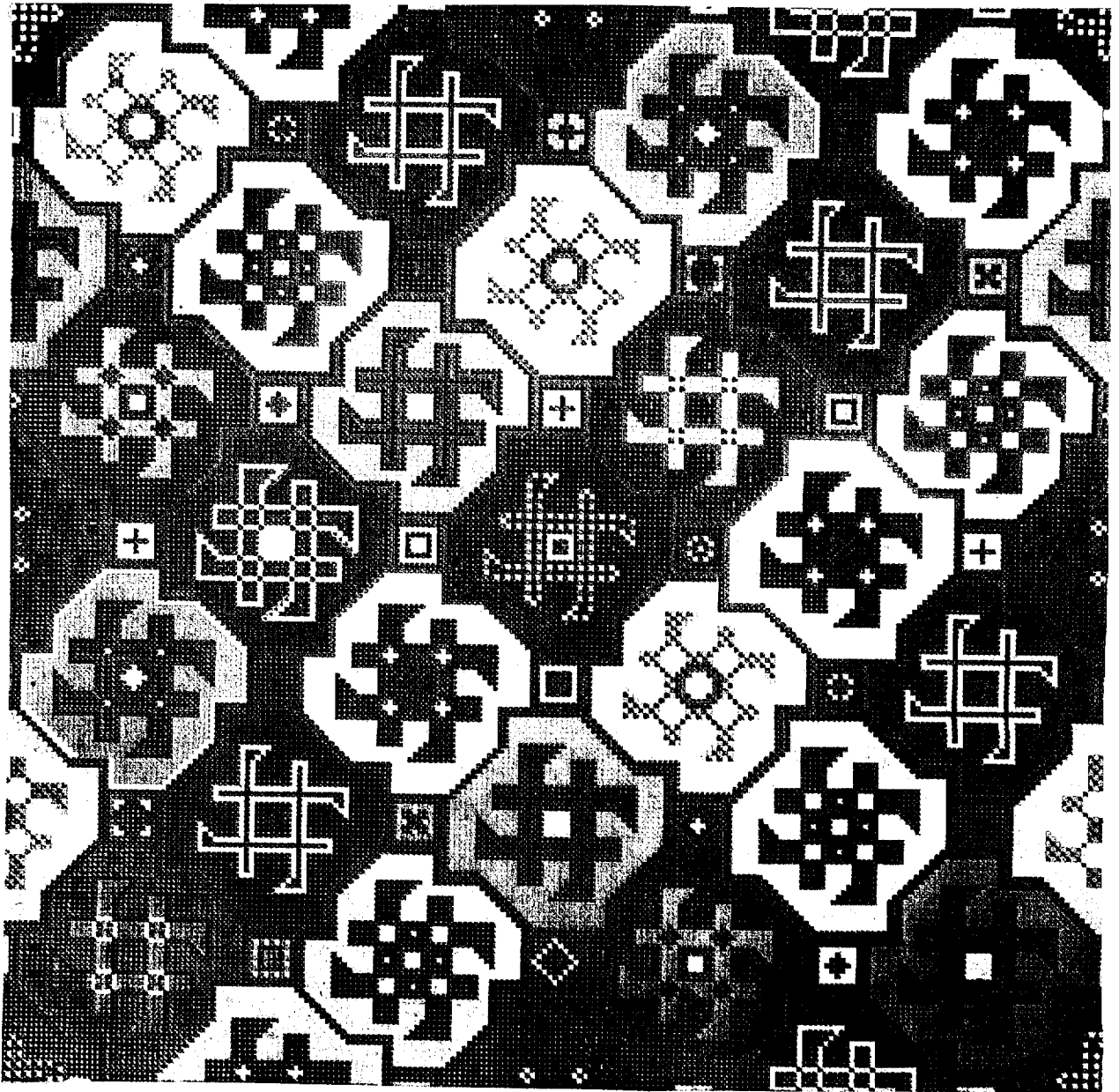

## DESIGN FOR OIL-CLOTH.

*To all whom it may concern:*
