
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a stacked pet treat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stacked pet treat according to a first embodiment;
FIG. 2 is a front view of the design shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a left side view of the design shown in FIG. 1, the right side view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top view of the design shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the design shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a stacked pet treat according to a second embodiment;
FIG. 7 is a front view of the design shown in FIG. 6;
FIG. 8 is a left side view of the design shown in FIG. 6, the right side view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 9 is a top view of the design shown in FIG. 6; and
FIG. 10 is a bottom view of the design shown in FIG. 6.
The broken lines shown in FIGS. 6-9 illustrate portions of the stacked pet treat that form no part of the claimed design.




















