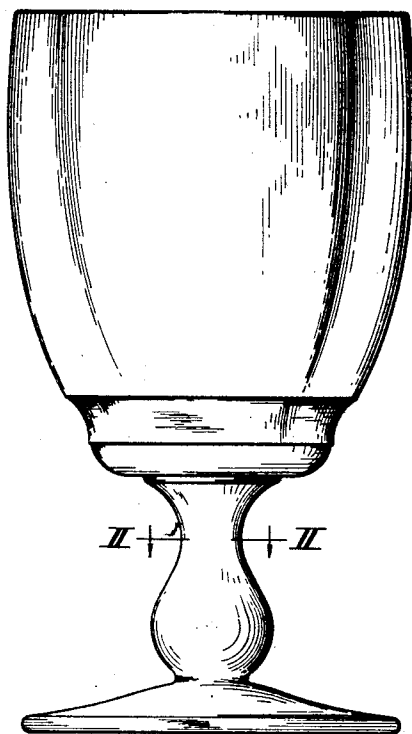
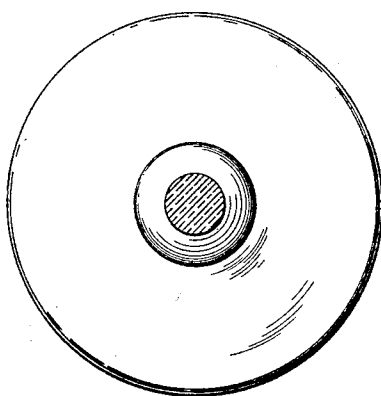

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE SAKIER, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Goblet or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a goblet or similar article, showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a sectional view thereof, taken on the line II—II of Fig. 1.
