To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Muriel J. Hughes, a citizen of the United States, residing in New York city, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a fabric showing my new design.

The dotted lines outline a design unit, which unit is repeated over the fabric as indicated by the extensions beyond the unit boundaries.
