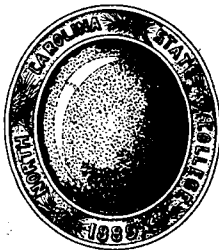

### DESIGN FOR A RING.

Application filed June 23, 1922. Serial No. 2,791. Term of patent 7 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, CHARLES W. BAILEY, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city and county of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Rings, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
