DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined videophone and mounting arrangement showing our new design, the mounting arrangement is omitted for ease of illustration;

FIG. 16 is an enlarged front side elevational view of FIG. 15;

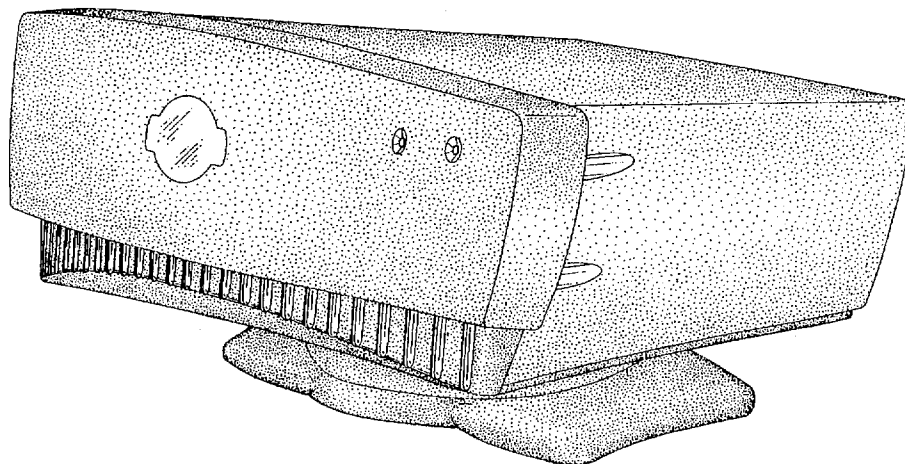
FIG. 17 is an enlarged back side elevational view of FIG. 15;

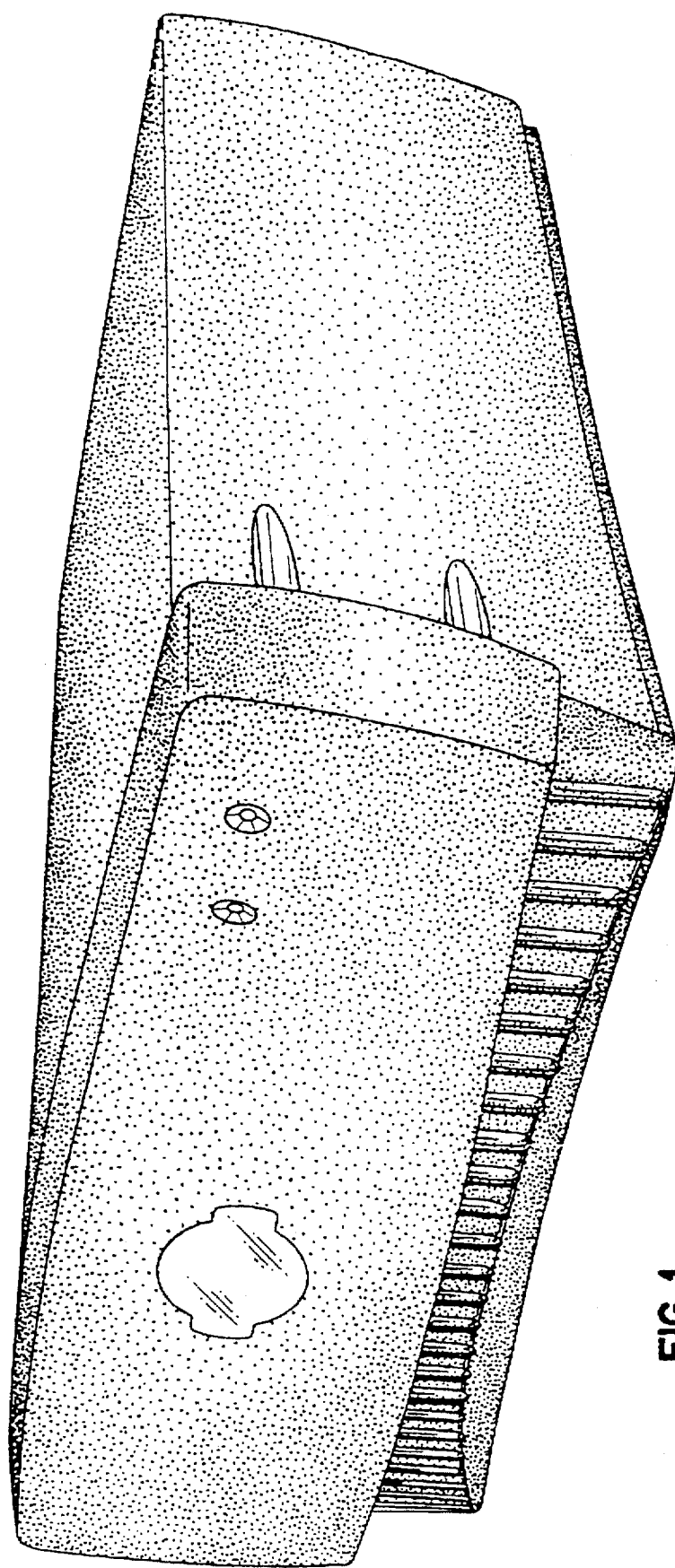

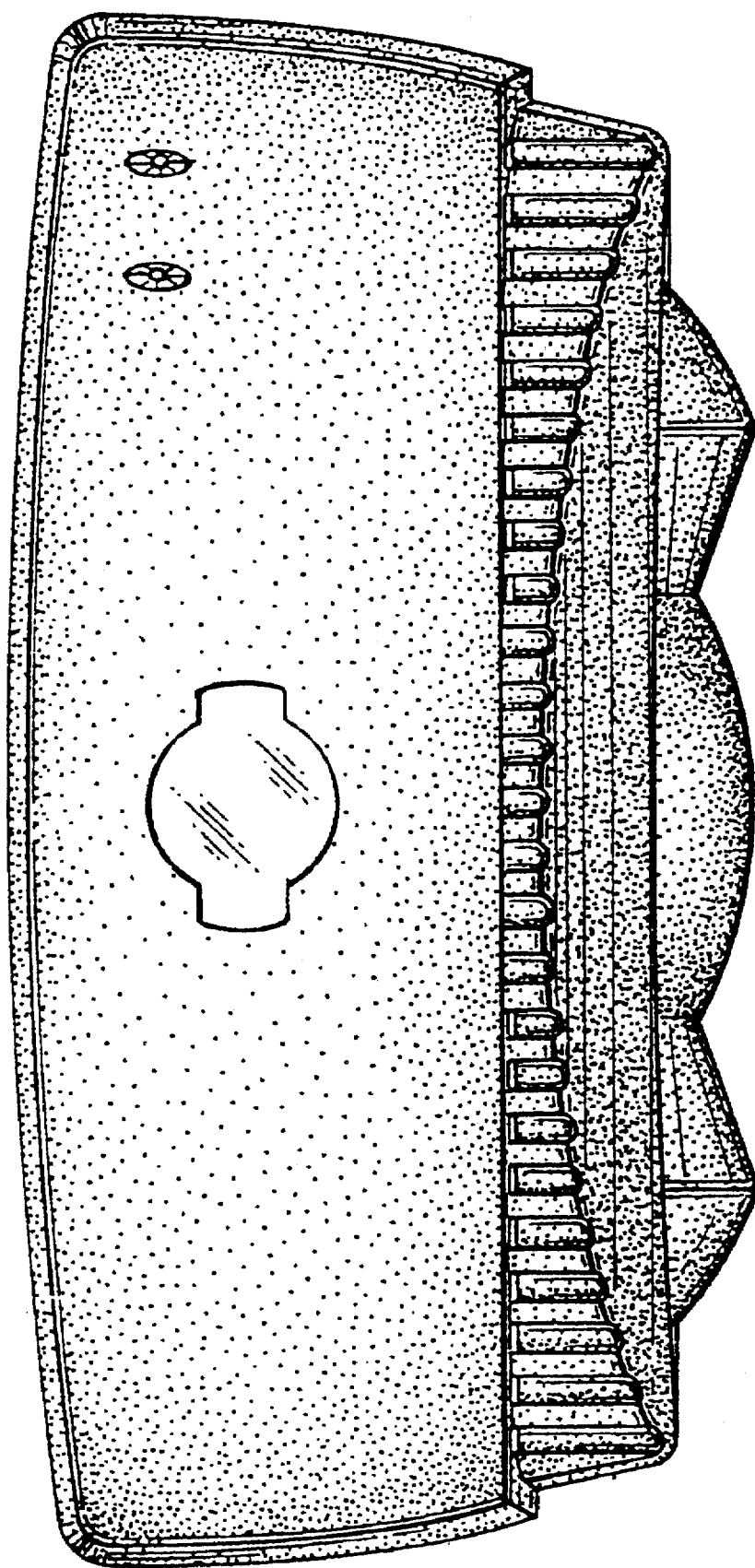

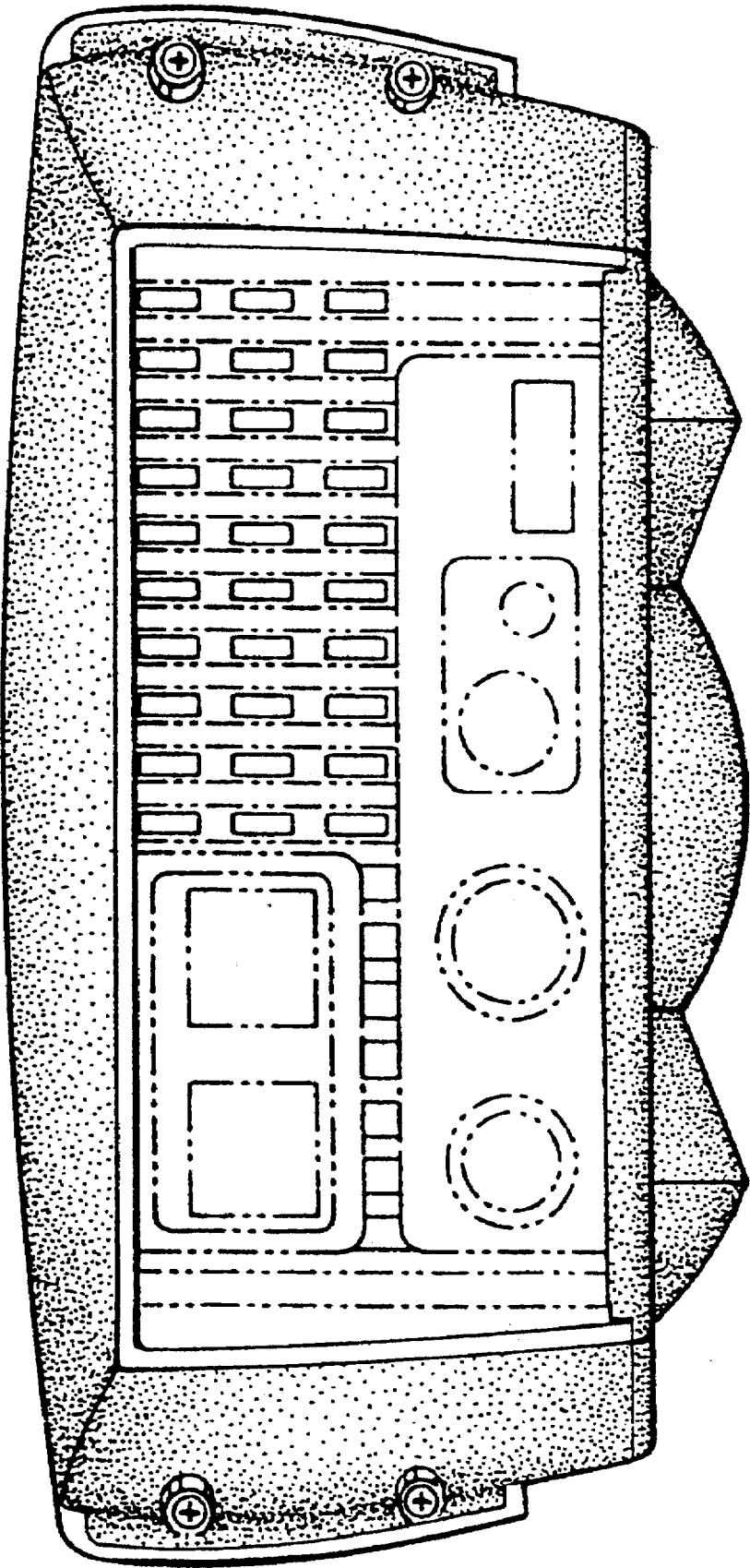

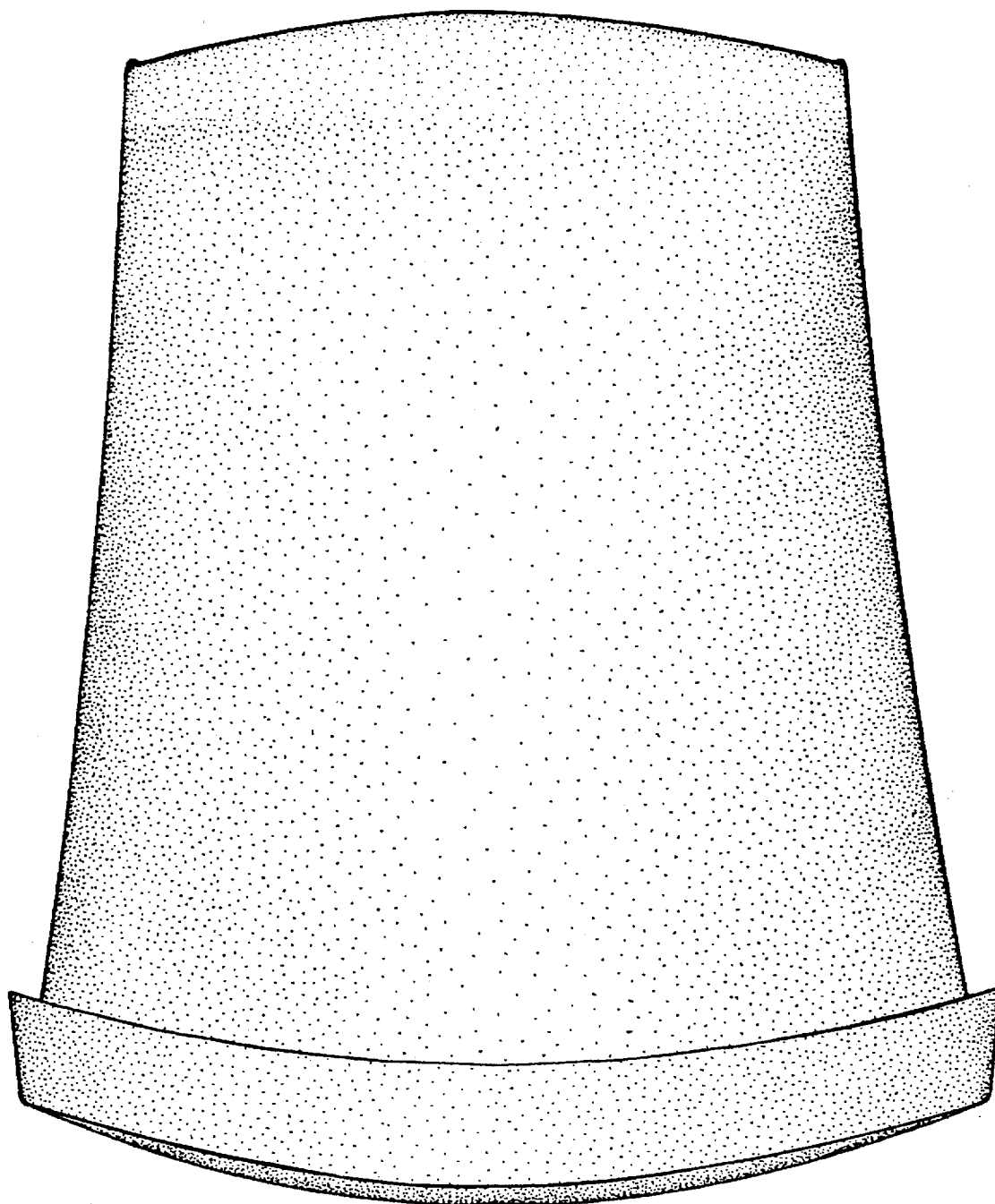

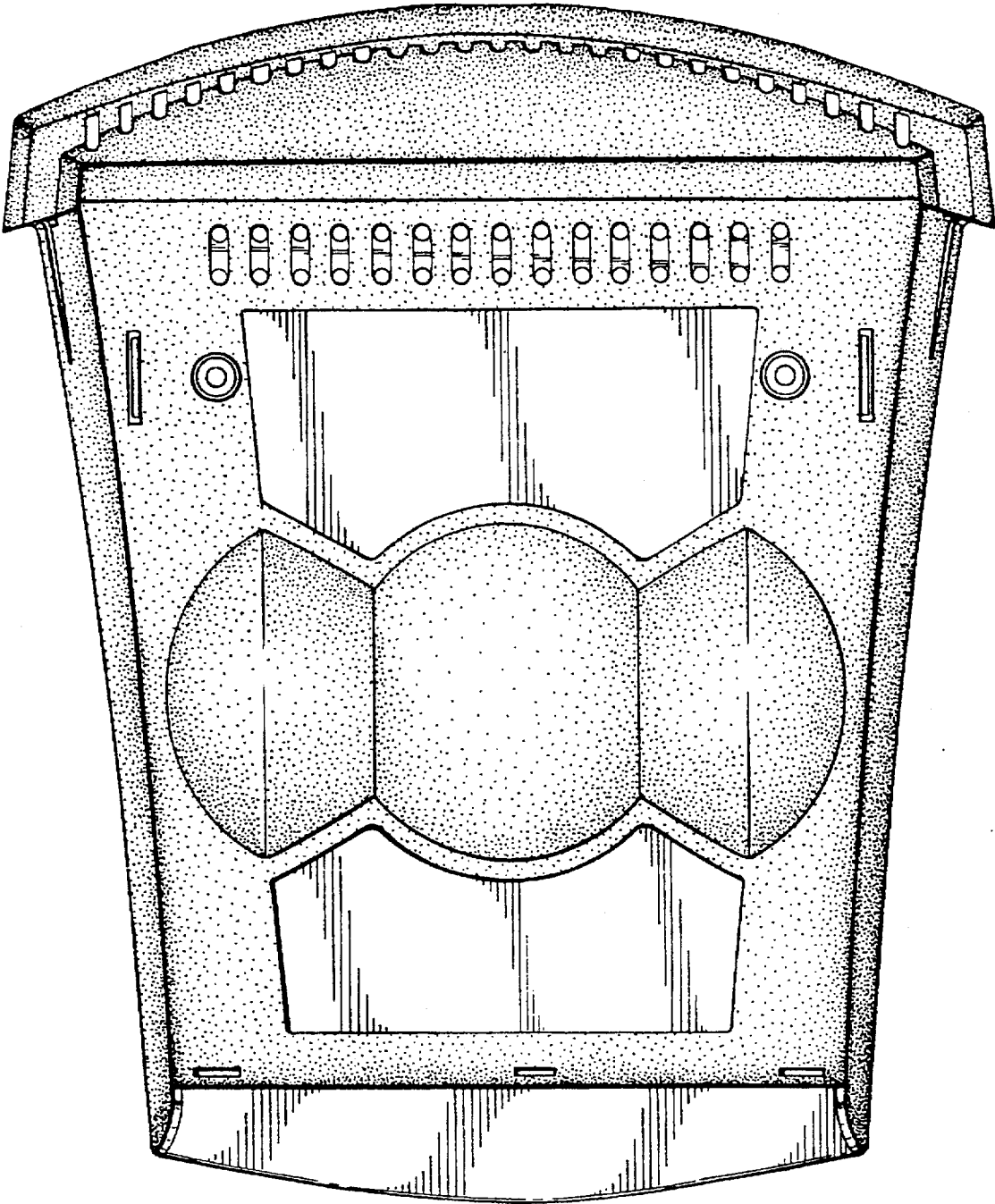

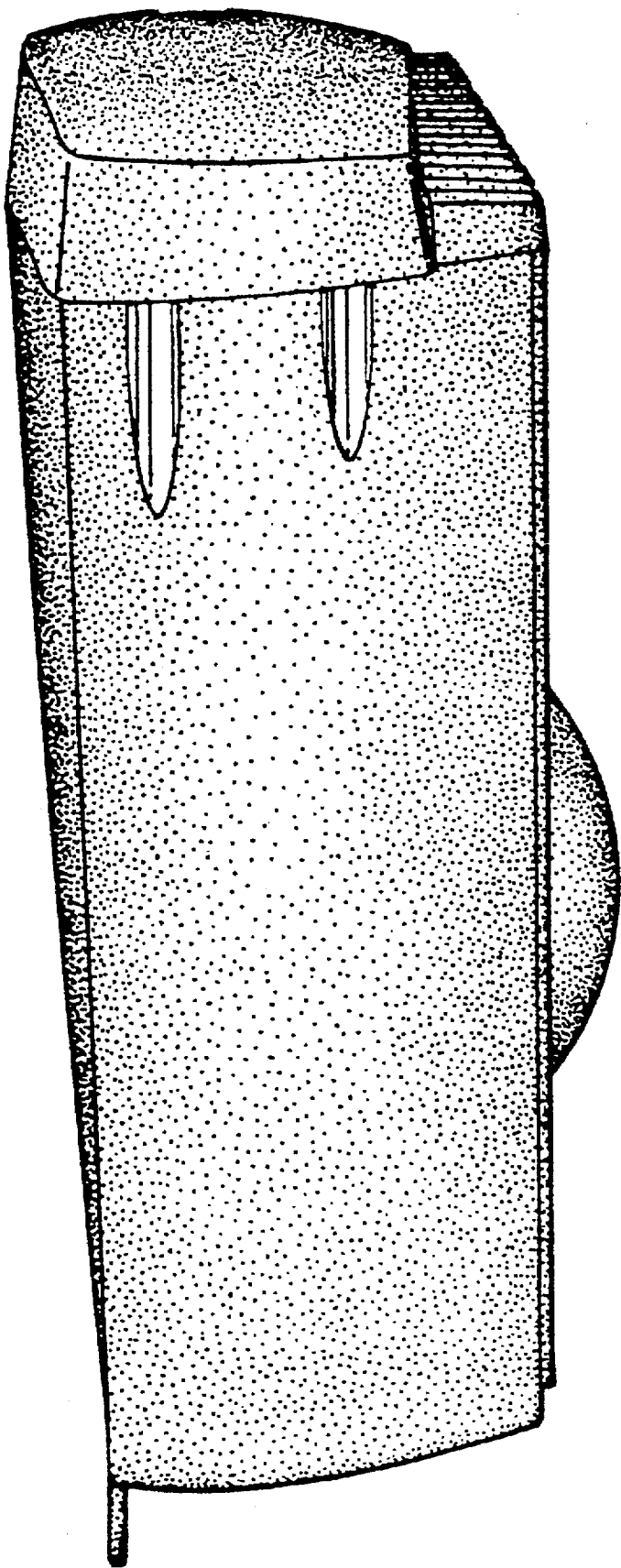
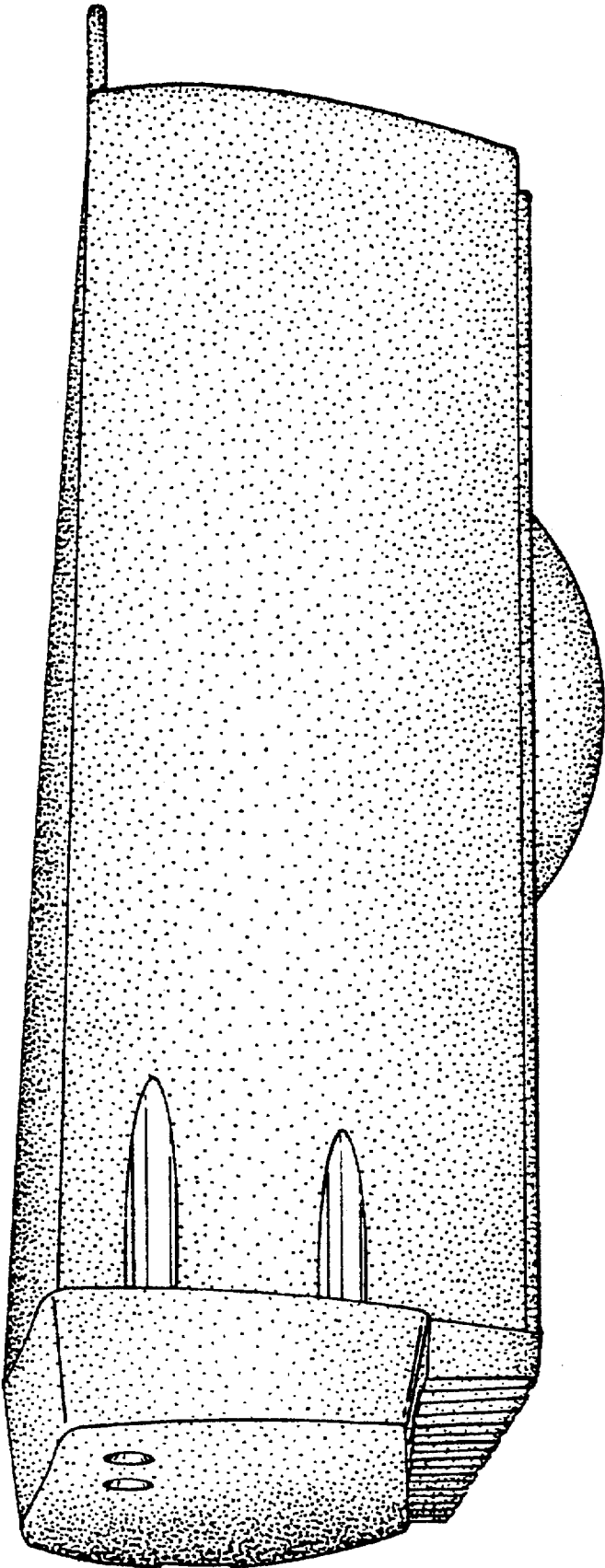

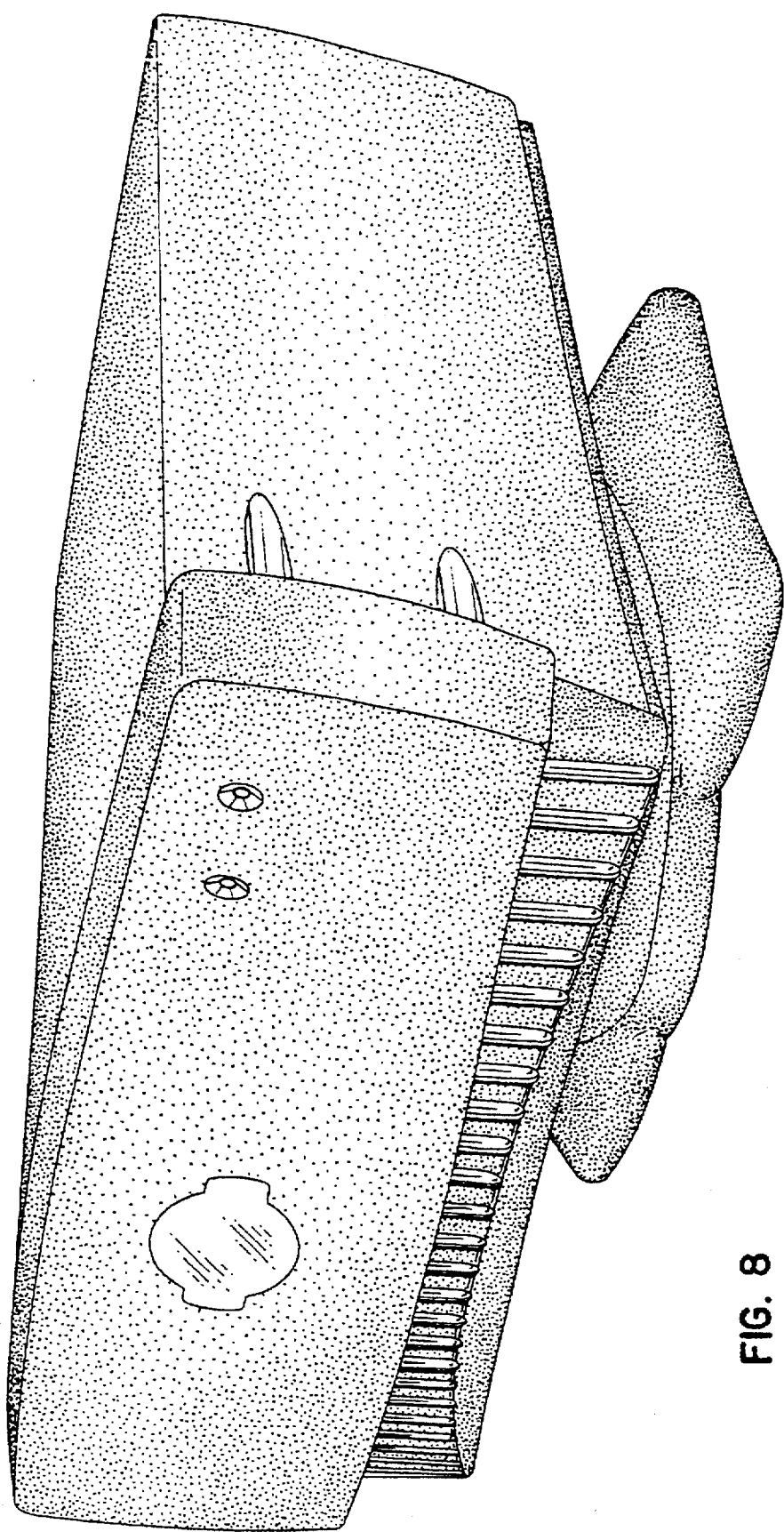

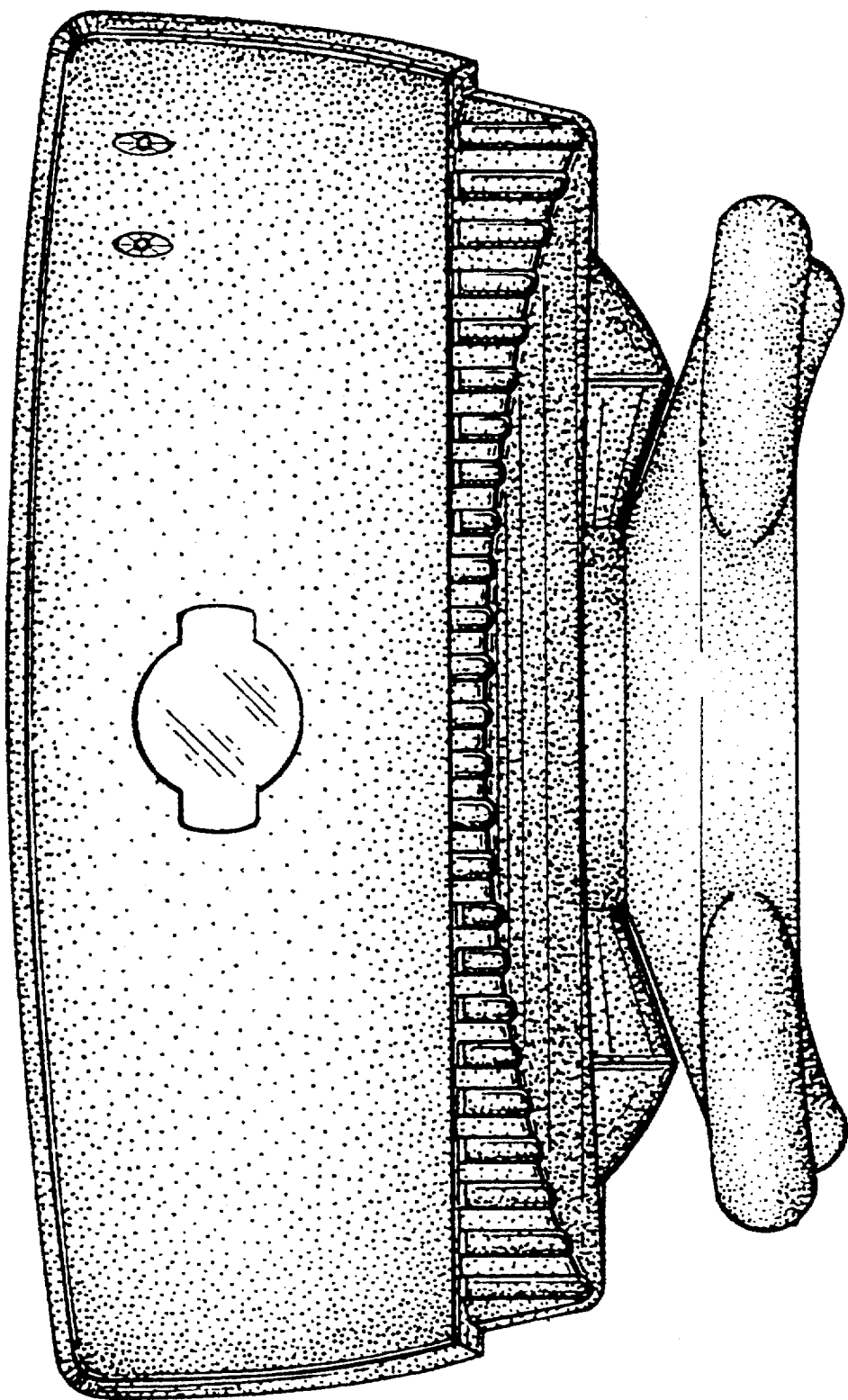

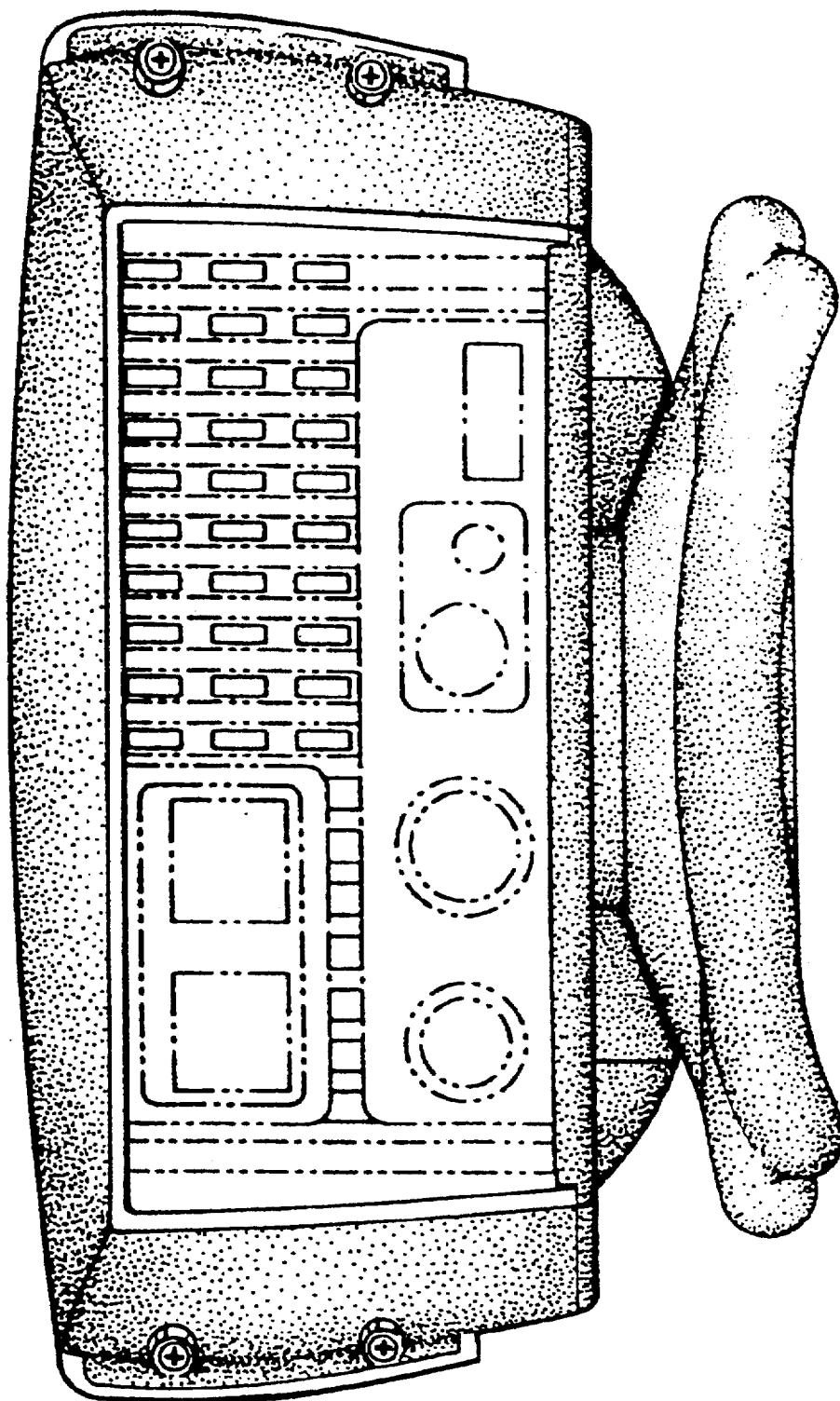

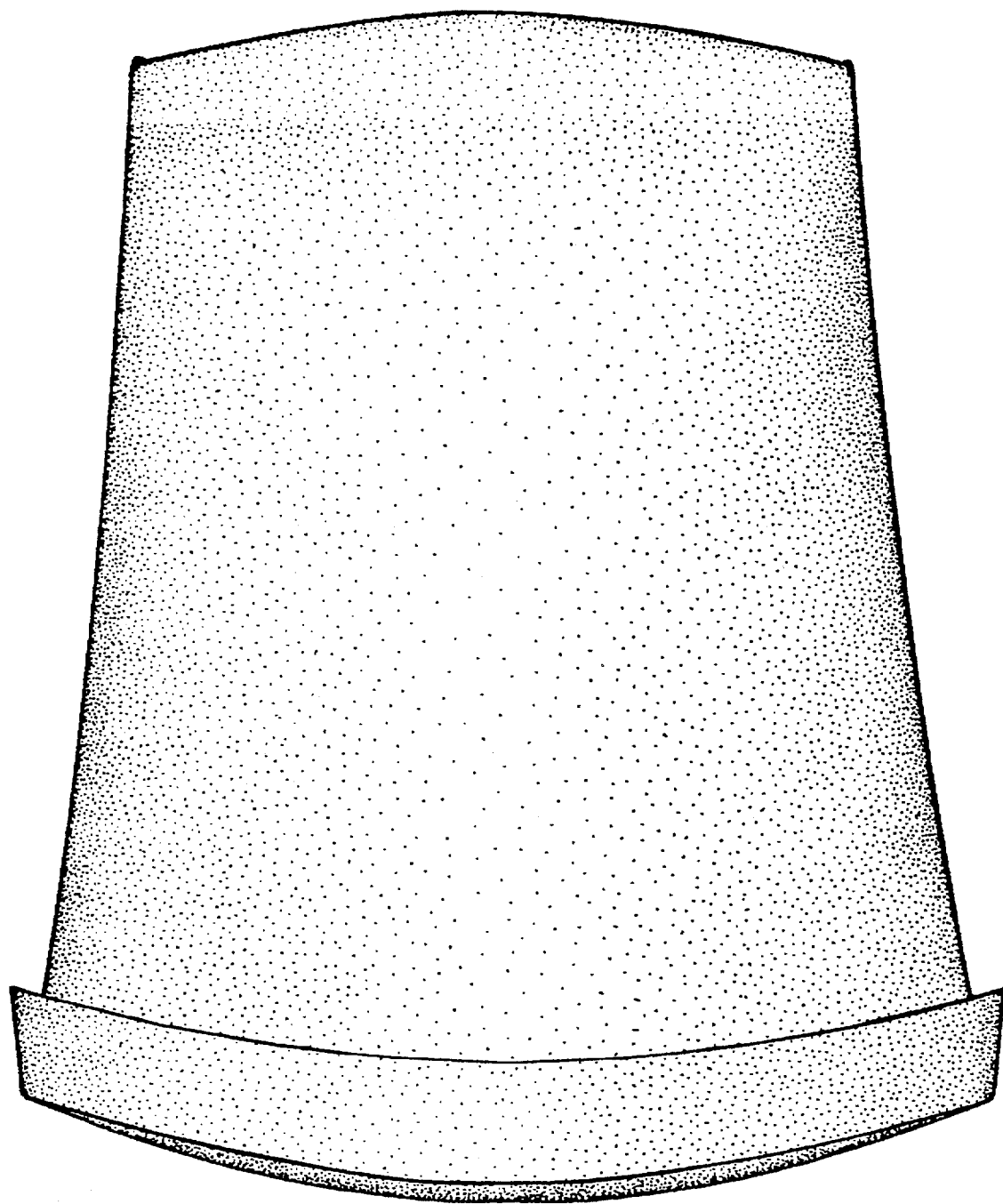

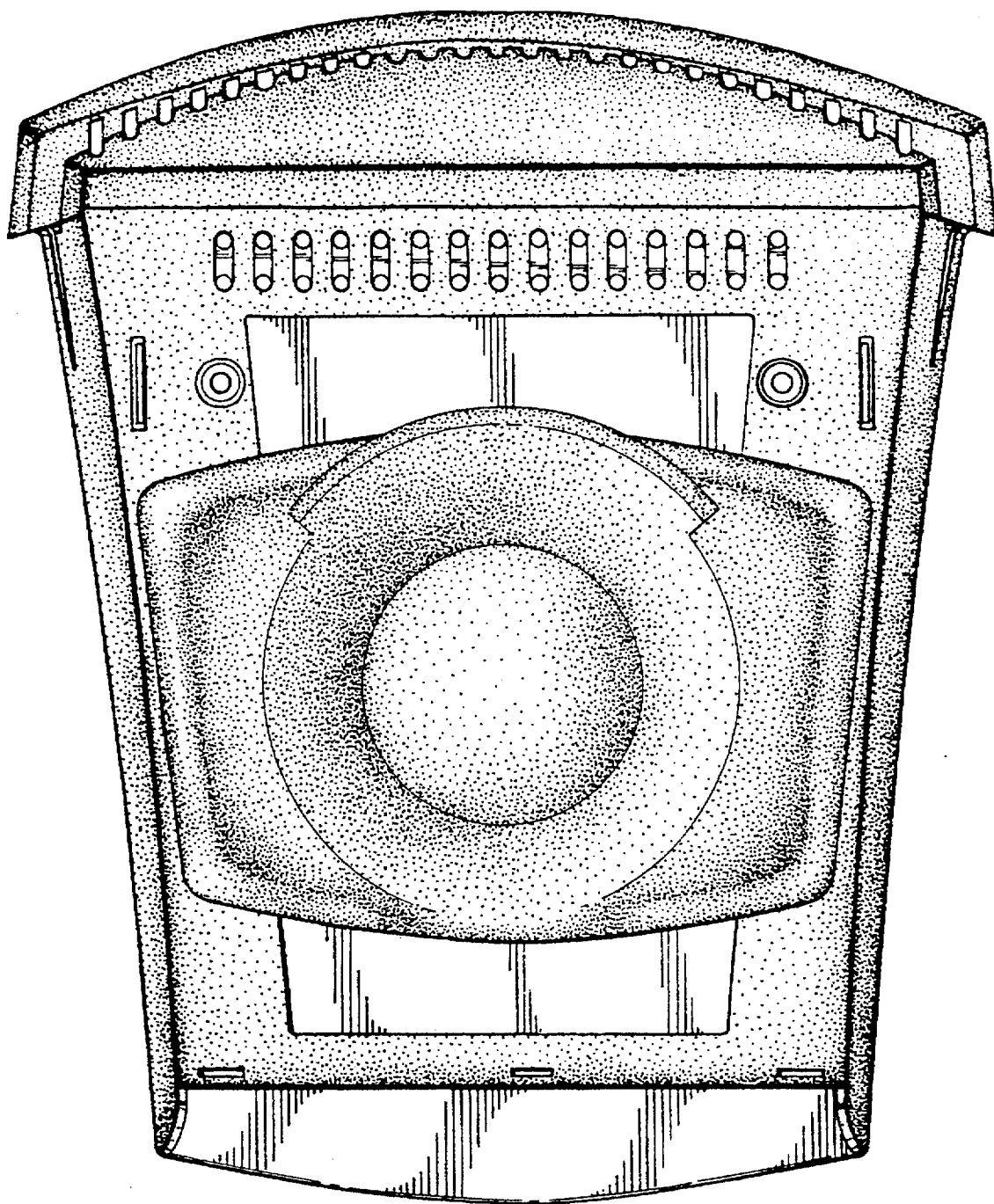

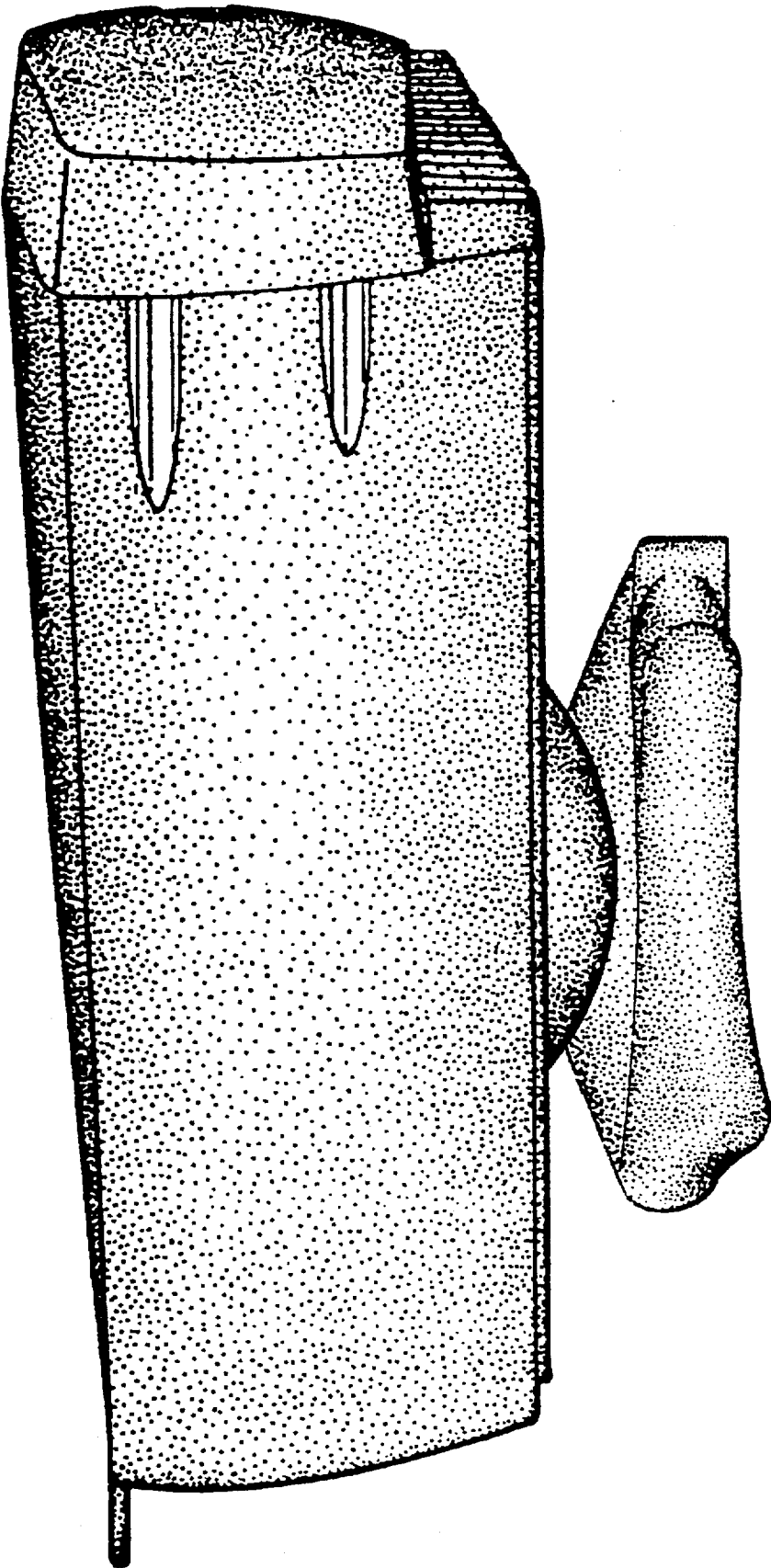
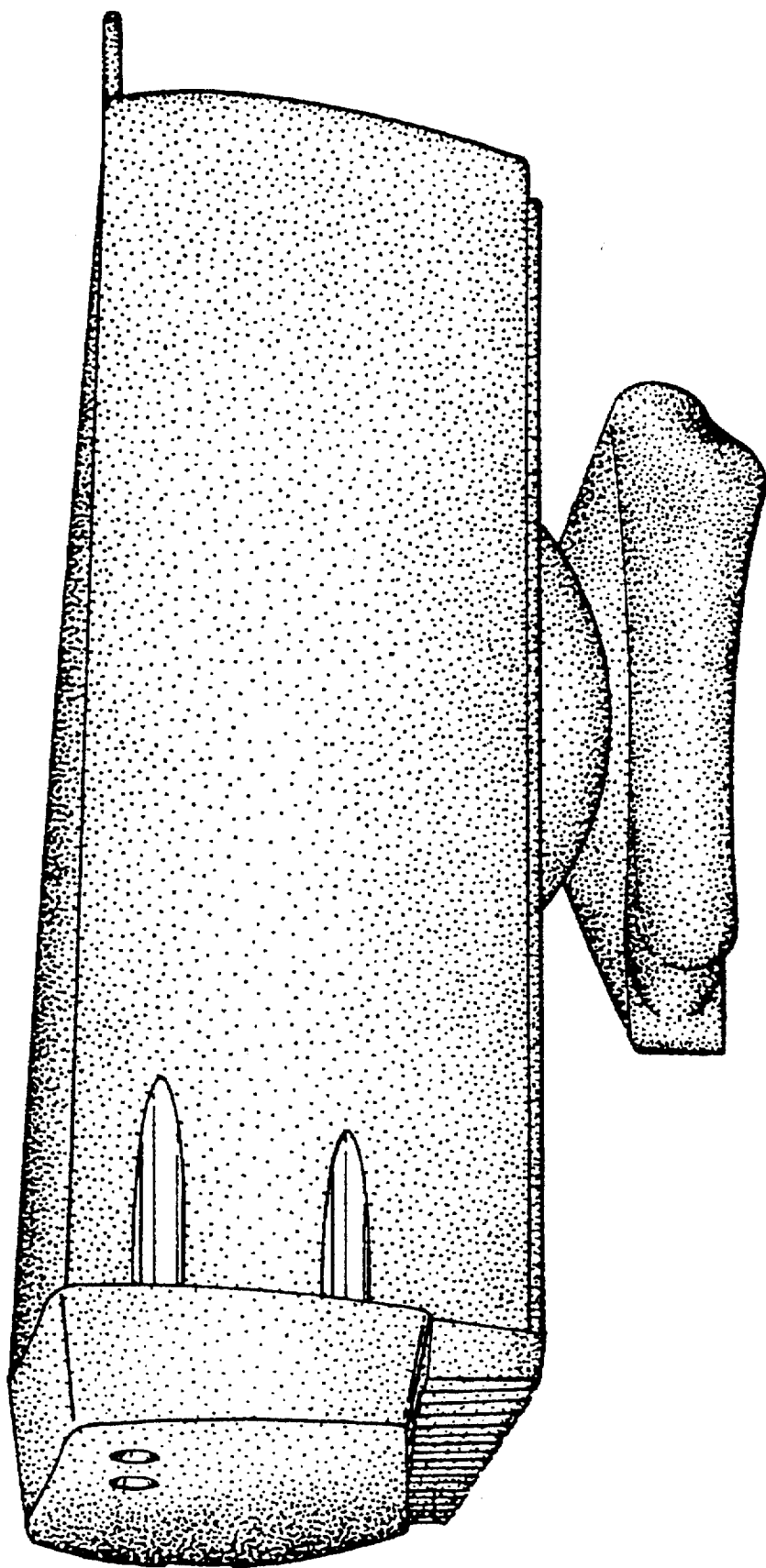

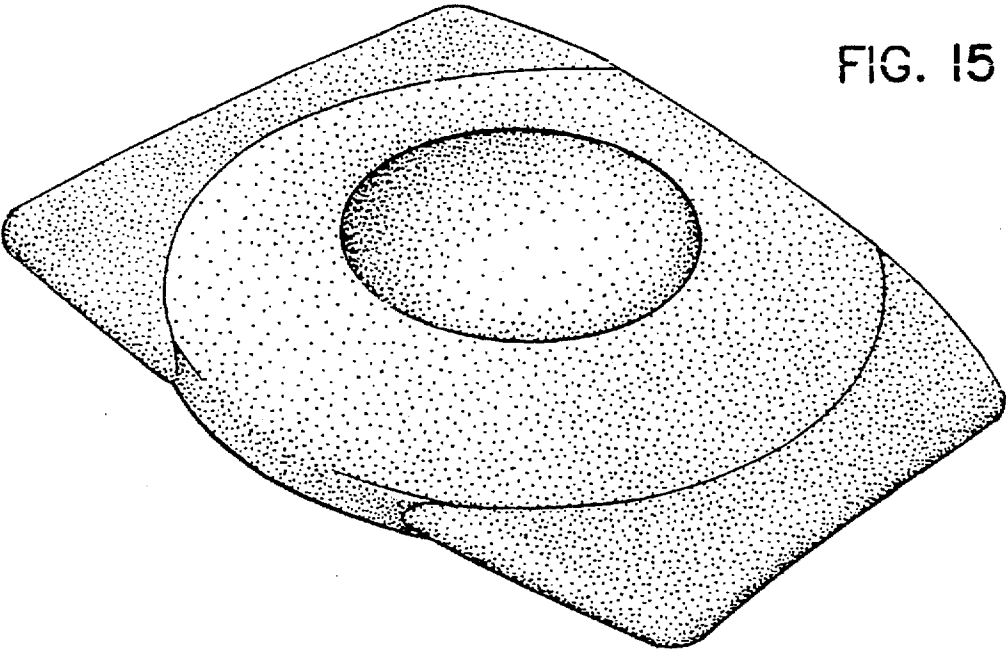

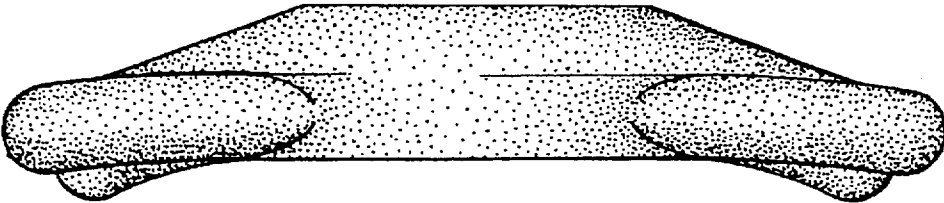

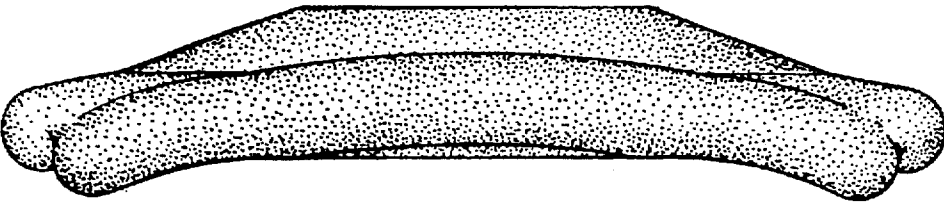

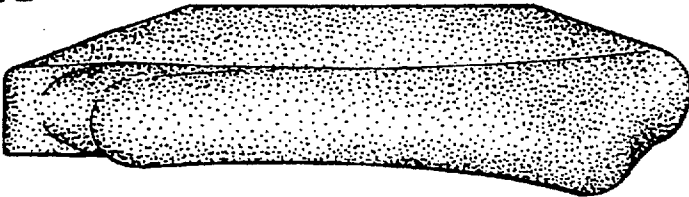

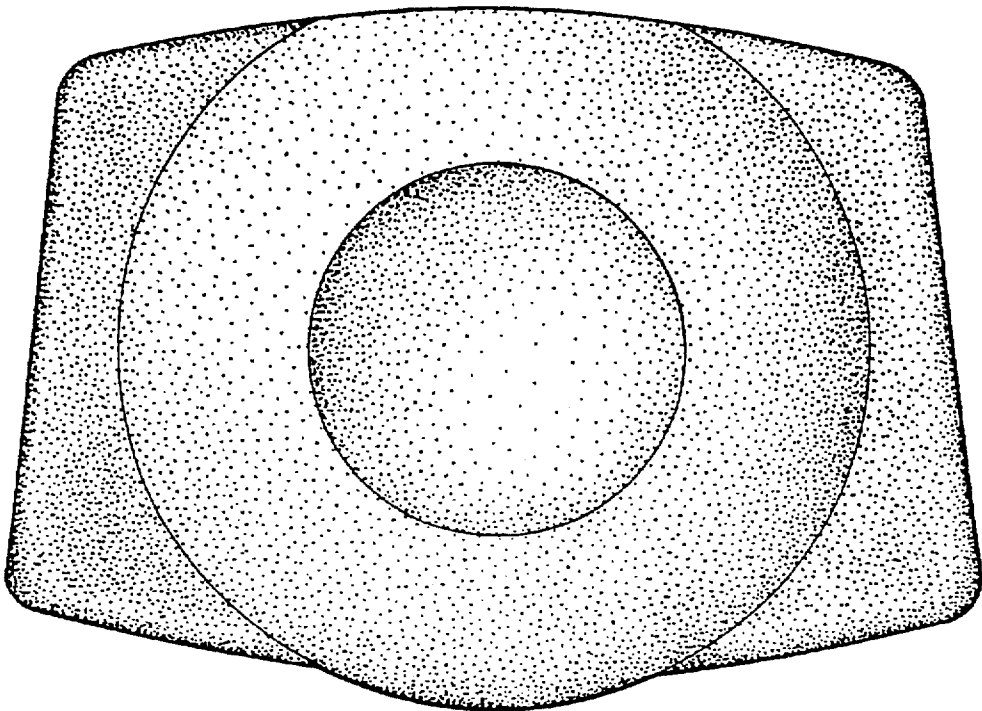
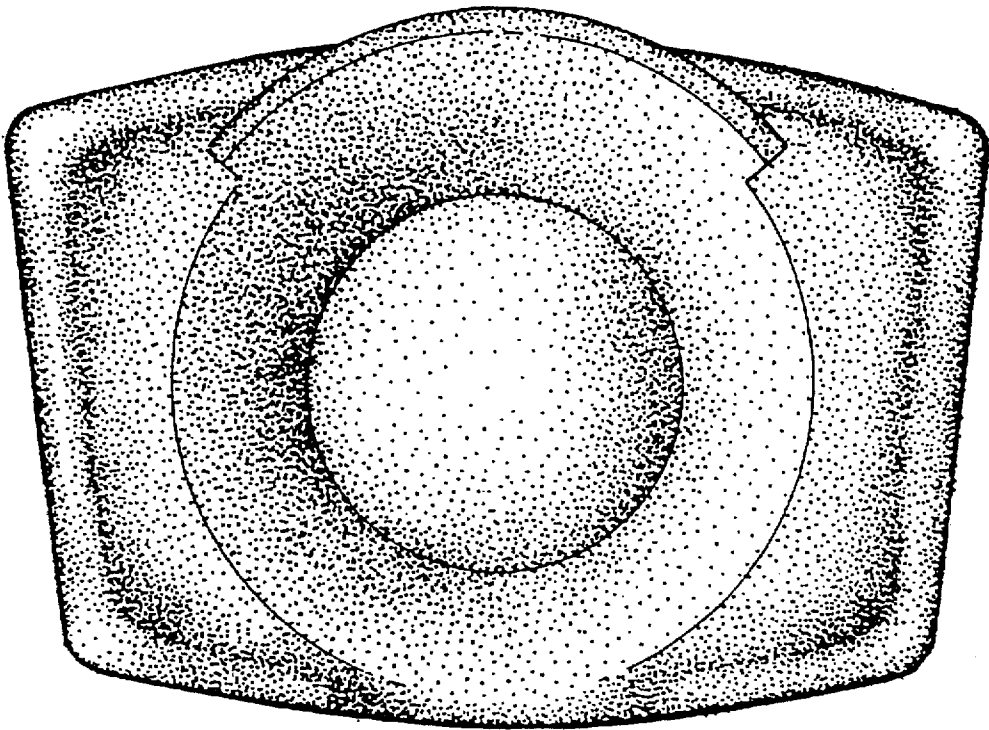
