(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chaise, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left rear perspective view of a chaise showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right front perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a right front perspective view thereof showing the chaise in a reclined position;

FIG. 8 is an enlarged, partial view of the chaise in FIG. 1, the portion taken at line-8; and,

FIG. 9 is an enlarged, partial view of the chaise in FIG. 5, the portion taken at line-9.

The broken lines represent environmental subject matter and form no part of the claimed design. The woven pattern shown on the backrest of the chaise, in FIGS. 1, 5 and 8, is continuous throughout.


















