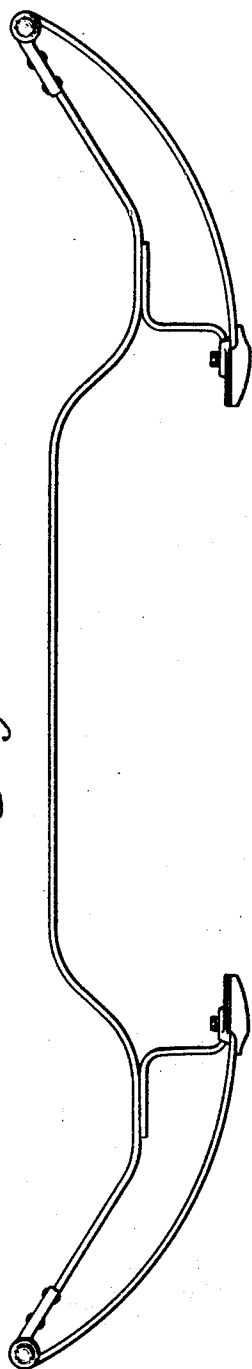
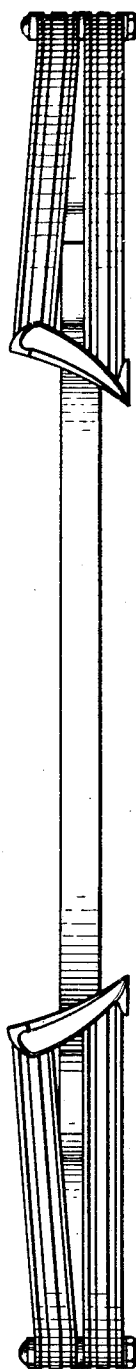

DESIGN FOR A BUMPER.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HERBERT S. JANDUS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Detroit, in the county of Wayne and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Bumpers, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying draw-
