

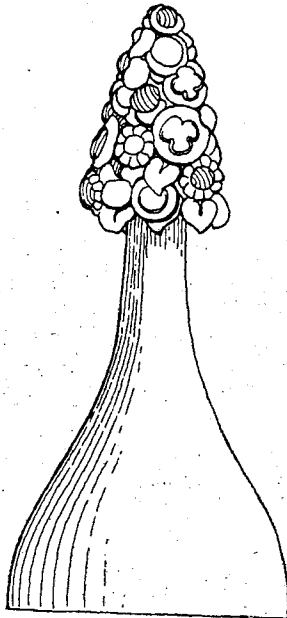

DESIGN FOR A BELL.

Application filed May 5, 1922. Serial No. 2,103. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM H. FULPER, a citizen of the United States of America, and resident of Flemington, in the county of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for Bells, of which the following is a specification, reference being had
