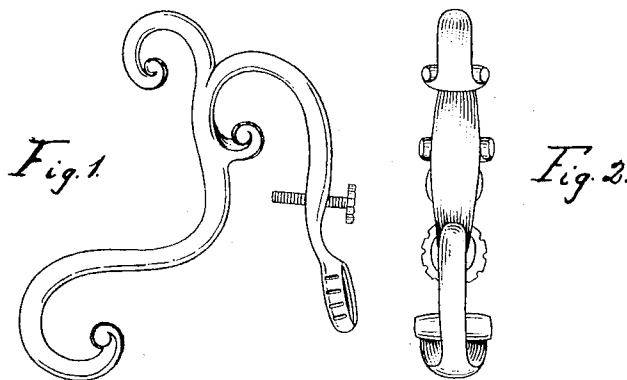

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRANK M. BROOKS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Hanger for Lighting-Bowls, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevation of a hanger

for lighting bowls, and Fig. 2 is a front elevation thereof, showing my new design.
