






To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph A. Potchen, a citizen of the United States, residing in Grand Rapids, county of Kent, State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Tray, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a tray embodying my new design.

Figure 2 is a vertical, cross-sectional view taken along the plane II—II of Figure 1.

Figure 3 is a side elevational view of the tray shown in Figure 1.

Figure 4 is an end elevational view of the tray shown in Figure 1.
