

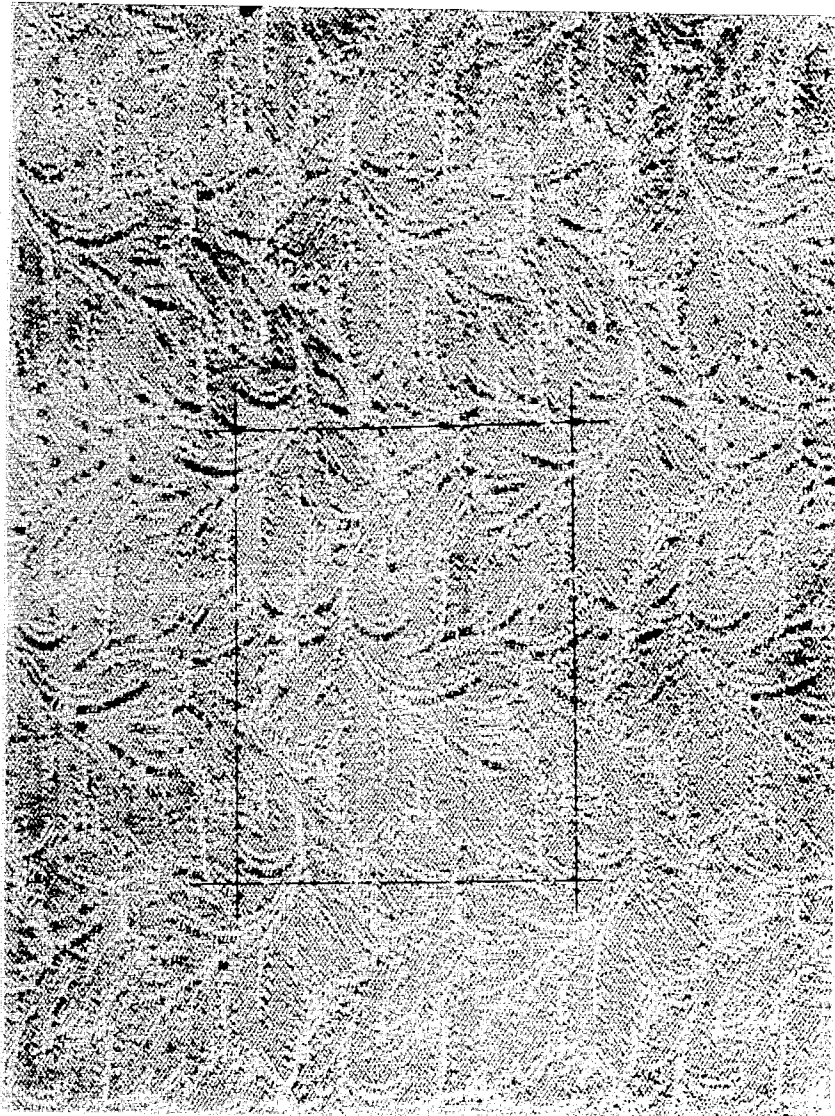

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Juanita G. Todd, a citizen of the United States, residing at Yonkers, in the county of Westchester and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pile Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure of the drawing is a plan view of a pile fabric, showing my new design, the design being shown in the rectangle formed by the broken lines and repeated as indicated.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a pile fabric, substantially as shown and described.
