

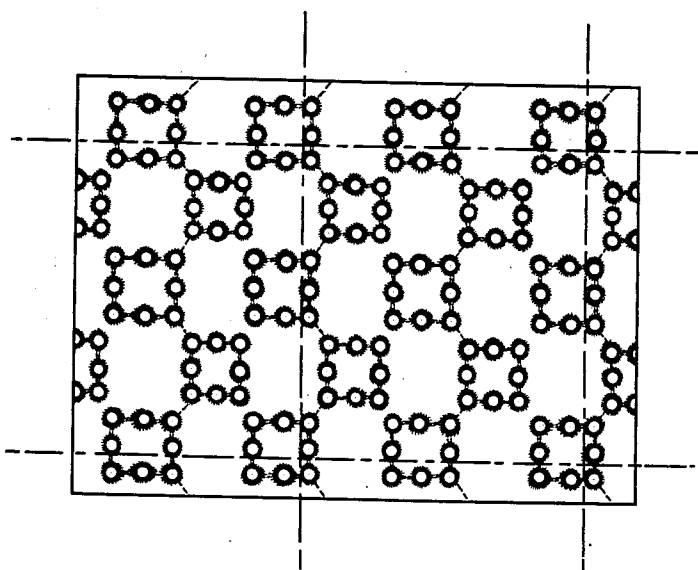

## EMBROIDERED EYELET FABRIC

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Walter Hallbauer, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in Union City, county of Bergen, and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Embroidered Eyelet Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure on the drawing is a surface view of an embroidered eyelet fabric showing my new design.

A design unit is outlined by broken lines and is repeated over the surface of the embroidered eyelet fabric as indicated.

I claim:

The ornamental design for an embroidered eyelet fabric, substantially as shown and described.
