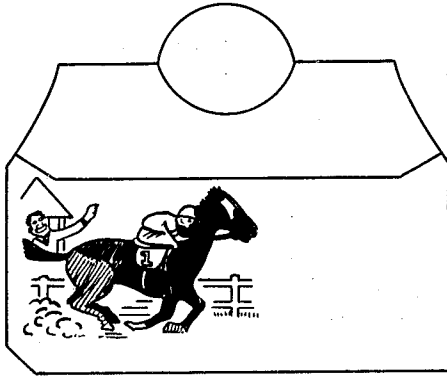

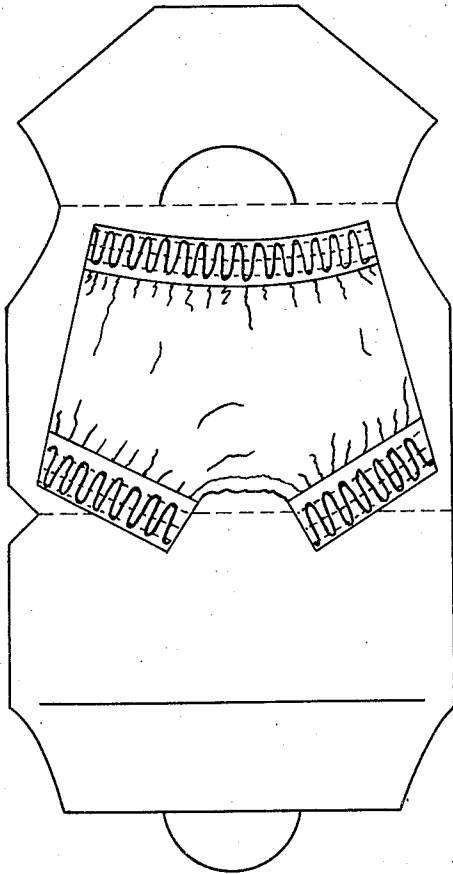

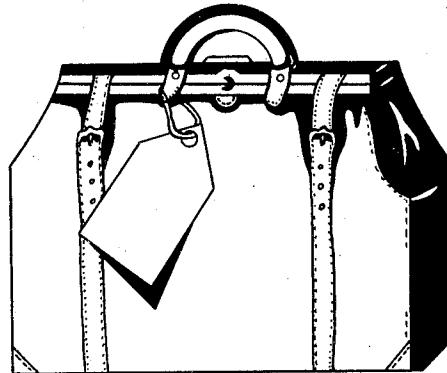

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Michael Jackson, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Mailing Folders, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a view in front elevation of a mailing folder, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a view of the same in rear elevation.

Fig. 3 is a view in elevation of the mailing folder in open position for display.
