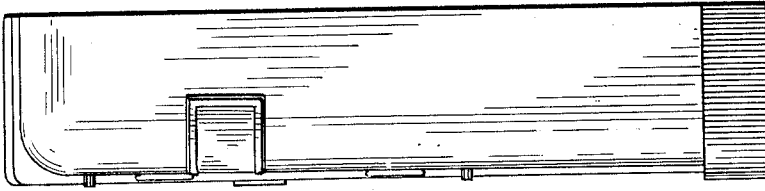

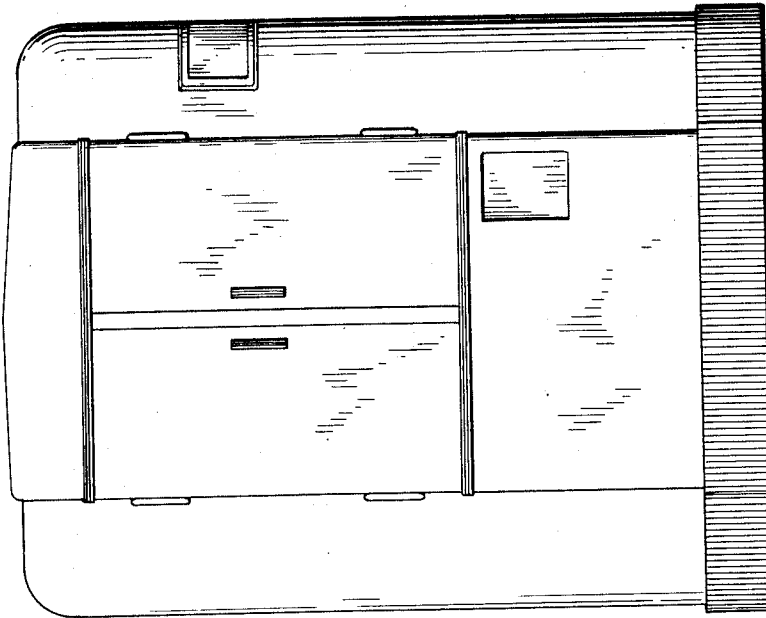

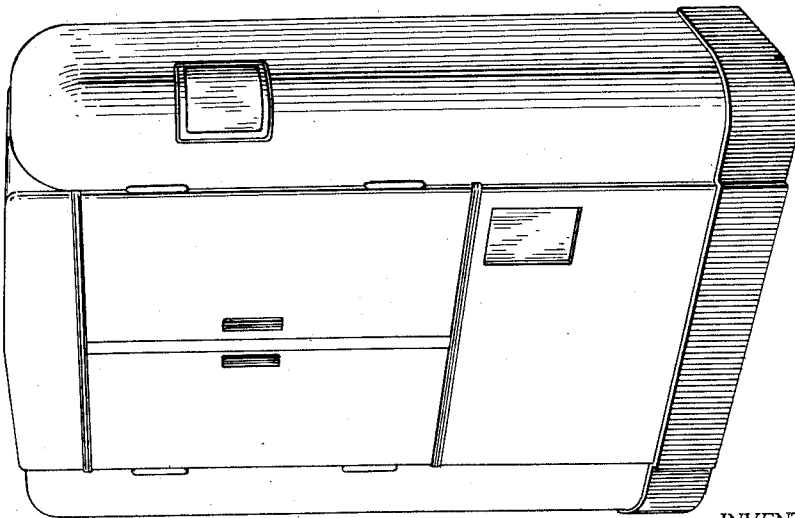

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Edgar N. Colson, a citizen of the United States, residing at Kansas City, in the county of Jackson and State of Missouri, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Drink Dispensing Machine, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
