Letter Patent No. 387, Dated June 17, 1851

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph G. Lamb of Cincinnati in the County of Hamilton & State of Ohio, have invented or produced a new Ornamental Design for Double oven Cooking Stoves, and I do hereby declare that the following is a full & exact description & the annexed drawings are a correct representation of the same To wit

Fig I is a perspective view of the whole stove.

Fig II. Section of cornice and ornaments & letters over front door

Fig III. plan view of Bonnets at either end of fire chamber. the ground of panels check, overlaid with rays verging from a circle, in the center of which is the number of the stove (in this size No. 2)

Fig IV. Outline of shape of bonnets

Fig V. star in center of lower oven doors

Fig VI. Star in center of upper oven doors

Fig VII Star in center of front door

Fig VIII Ornaments in slide of front door -

Fig IX Ornaments in front panels -

Fig X shape of door mouldings

Fig XI. base & bottom mouldings

Fig XII. Cornice & Top mouldings

Fig XIII Moulding around hearth.

Fig XIV Corners of body of stove. The panels of the front & 4 oven doors are a check ground overlaid with unequal length rays diverging from stars in their centers as shown. Corresponding figures are corresponding parts as seen on Fig. I.
