(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a ring-like wearable electronic device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an enlarged front perspective view of a ring-like wearable electronic device showing our new design;

FIG. 2, is a right orthogonal view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear orthogonal view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top orthogonal view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front orthogonal view thereof;

FIG. 6, is a left orthogonal view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a bottom orthogonal view thereof;

FIG. 8 is an enlarged front perspective view of a modified embodiment of this design;

FIG. 9, is a right orthogonal view of the modified embodiment;

FIG. 10 is a rear orthogonal view of the modified embodiment;

FIG. 11 is a top orthogonal view of the modified embodiment;


FIG. 12 is a front orthogonal view of the modified embodiment;




























