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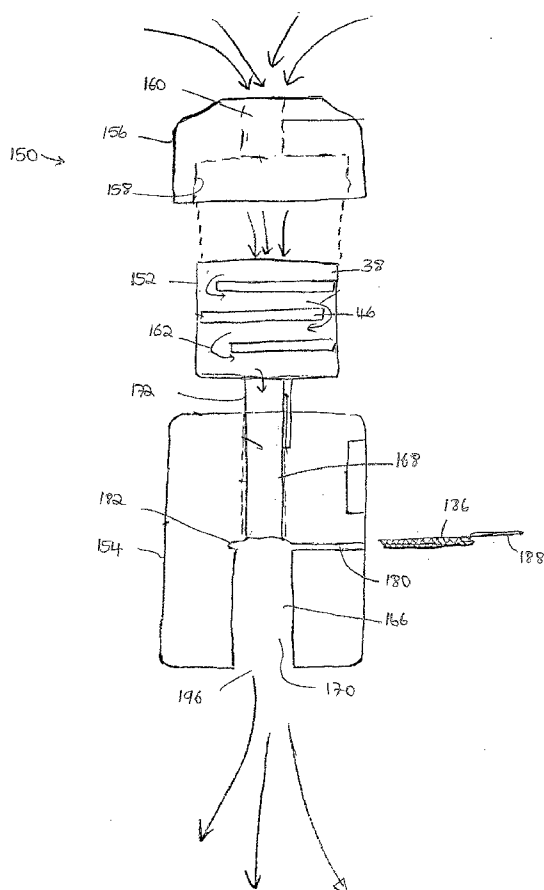
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(54) **Title:** AROMATIC FRAGRANCE DISPENSER



(57) **Abstract:** A fragrance dispenser comprises a receptacle for receiving an aromatic substance to be heated; and a heat exchanger connected to the receptacle for heating air upstream of the receptacle, the heat exchanger having means for agitating the air as it is heated and passes therethrough.



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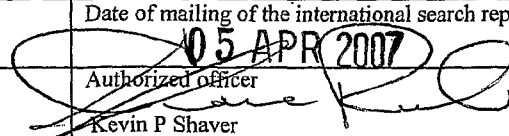
