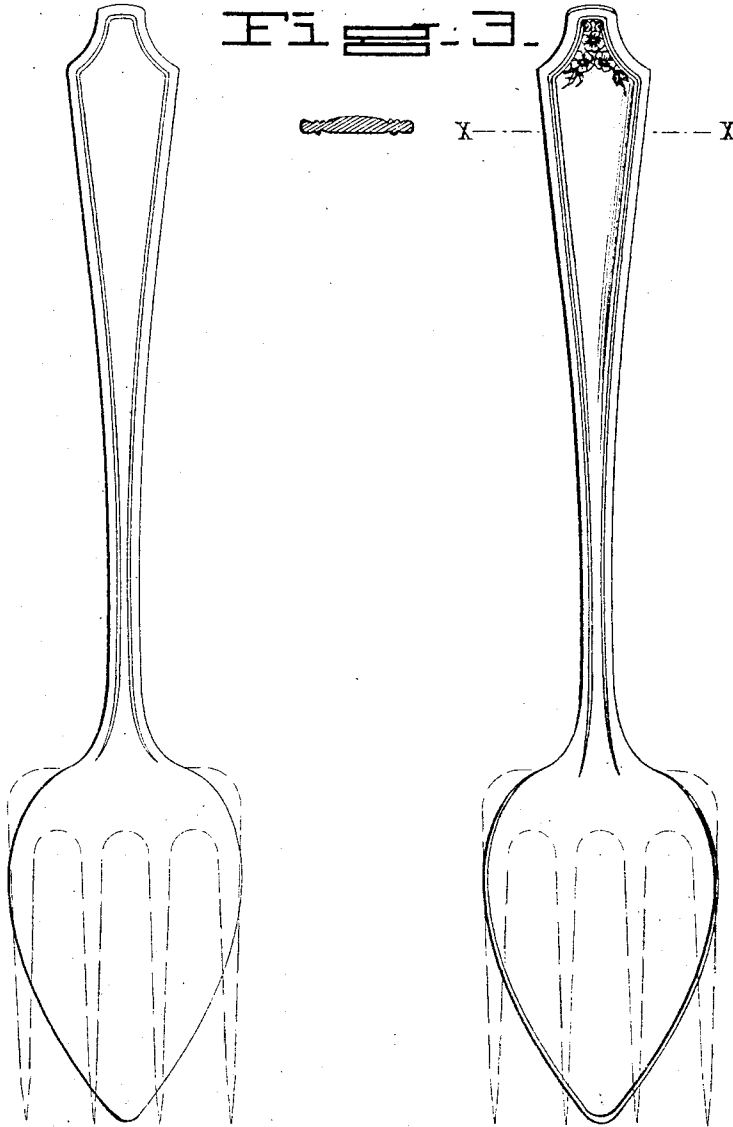

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SIDNEY V. JAMES, a citizen of the United States, residing at Niagara Falls, in the county of Niagara and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Handle for a Spoon, Fork, or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein—

handle for a spoon, fork or similar article, showing my new design;

Fig. 2, a reverse view; and
