DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of an I/O terminal for data communication showing my new design;

FIG. 8 is a front, top right side perspective view thereof with the cover in the open position.

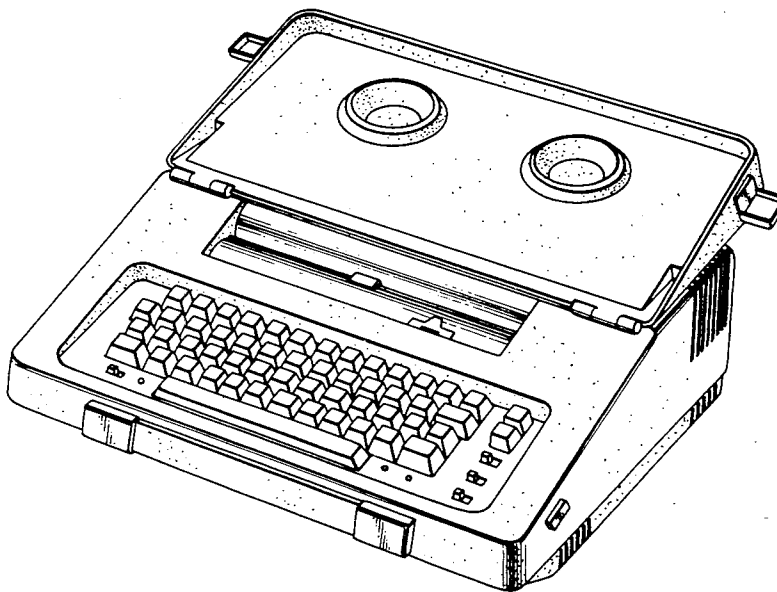

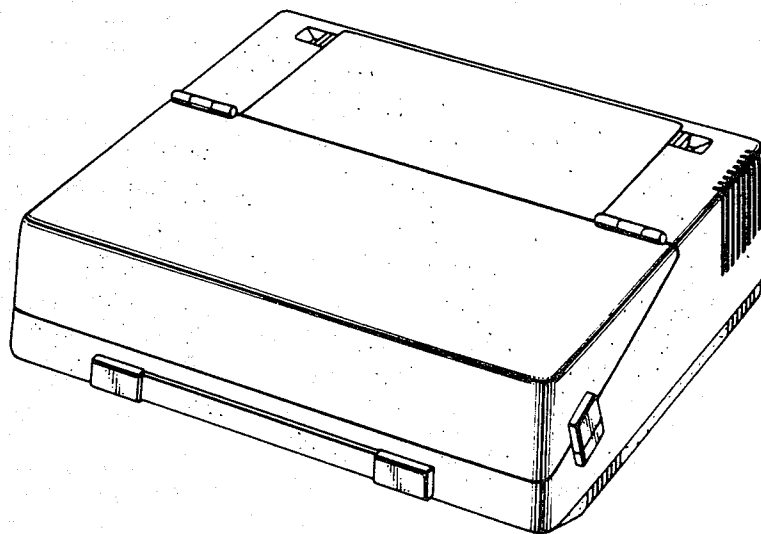

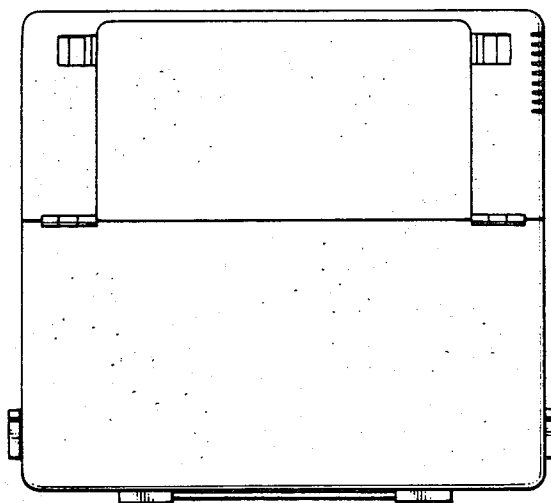

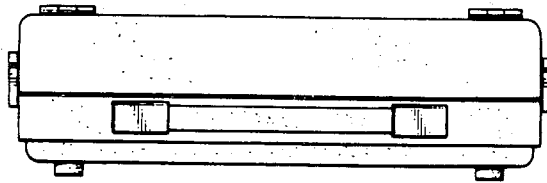

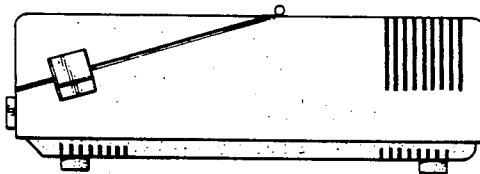

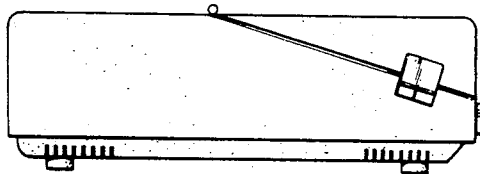

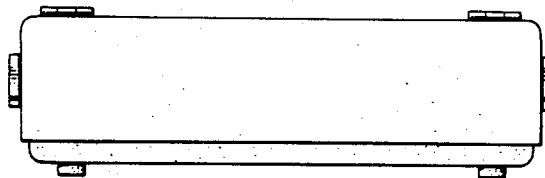

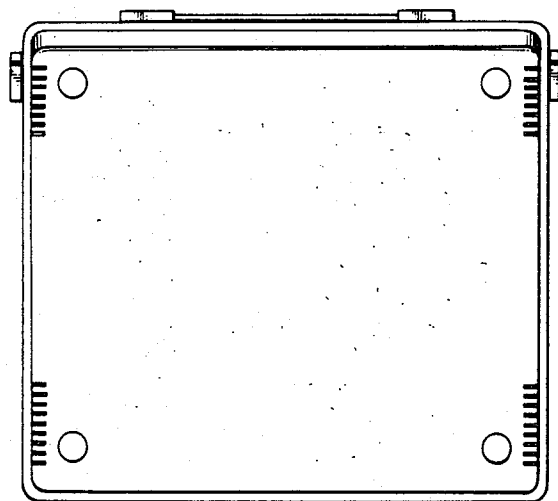
