

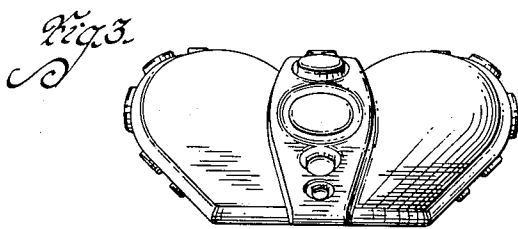
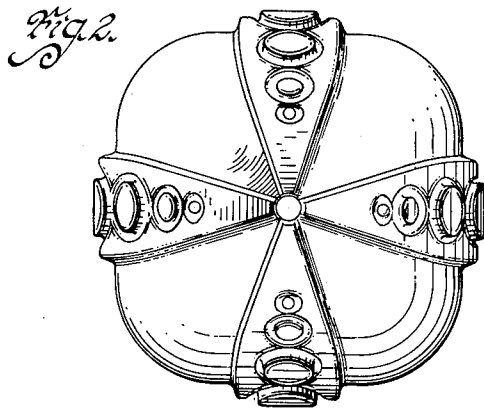
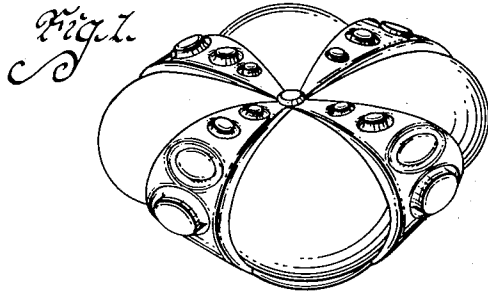

**DESIGN FOR A CAKE OF SOAP**

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Albert Mosheim, a citizen of the United States and a resident of New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for a Cake of Soap, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a cake of soap illustrating my new design.

Figure 2 is a top plan view of the cake of soap; and

Figure 3 is a side elevation of the same.
